<p>This large event encouraged and supported by the European Commission - DG EAC – and co-organised by the three regional SALTO Resources Centres (EuroMed, EECA &amp; SEE) and the French National Agency, will gather 150 youth workers to the launching of the new Action 3.1 of the Youth in Action Programme.</p>	
<p><b>OBJECTIVES OF THE FAIR</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To inform about the philosophy and the priorities of the Youth in Action Programme</li> <li>• To present the Neighbourhood Policy of the European Commission</li> <li>• To offer the participants the opportunity to meet and initiate project ideas for projects involving countries in the neighbouring regions</li> <li>• To provide the participants with information and tools for organising projects with neighbouring countries</li> </ul>
<p><b>FRAMEWORK and METHODOLOGY</b></p>	<p>The fair will be run by an international team of facilitators and representatives of the organisers. Participative working methods will be used, such as teamwork, discussion, sharing of knowledge and experiences, exercises, and learning-by-doing.</p>
<p><b>WORKING LANGUAGE</b></p>	<p>English</p>
<p><b>NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS</b></p>	<p>150 participants will be invited: 20 from each of the three neighbouring regions (SEE, EEAC and EuroMed) as well as 70 from the programme countries. SALTO-YOUTH SEE RC will support 20 participants from South East Europe: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, FYRO Macedonia, Serbia (UNMIK Kosovo) and Montenegro.</p>
<p><b>PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS</b></p>	<p>Priority will be given to applicants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Who come from organisations that have the strong intention to initiate projects with the neighbouring partner countries,</li> <li>• Who have already some experience or show great interest in developing international projects</li> <li>• Representatives of contact organisations in the regions and of the National Agencies</li> </ul>
