<p>AIMS OF THE COURSE</p>	<p>Main aims of the training course:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To train participants to develop quality projects with themes related to the four priorities. - To facilitate contact making and the first steps of project development. - To introduce Youthpass/Key Competences to the participants <p>It aims to prepare participants for organising projects with a clear focus on YiA programme priorities, in particular youth participation in civil society and European citizenship and a result oriented outcome.</p> <p>The four priorities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) European citizenship 2) Participation of young people 3) Cultural diversity 4) Inclusion
<p>WORKING LANGUAGE</p>	<p>English</p>
<p>NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS</p>	<p>35 participants, 20 from South East Europe and 15 from programme countries</p>
<p>PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS</p>	<p>The course targets project organisers from SEE and Programme Countries. They should have some (limited) experience in developing projects under the YOUTH programme. Participants should be interested in developing projects under actions 2 or 3.1.</p>



<p>DATES AND VENUE OF THE COURSE</p>	<p>The course will be held in Albania (exact venue will be confirmed till end of September)</p> <p>The course will begin on Saturday, 17 November 2007 evening and will end on Thursday, 22 November 2007 morning. Participants are expected to arrive on Saturday, 17 November 2007, and to leave on Thursday, 22 November 2007.</p>
<p>TEAM</p>	<p>The training course will be prepared by a team including a representative of the SALTO SEE Resource Centre and two trainers.</p>
<p>TRAINER PROFILE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Overall trainer skills with regard to working with international groups in non-formal educational and youth work settings; ▪ Sound knowledge about the different Actions of the Youth in Action programme and its priorities; ▪ Experience in using methods that can be used to create self-responsibility and to stimulate ideas, discussion and plans for the future. ▪ Knowledge about / experience using Key competences (Youthpass)
<p>PREPARATION MEETING</p>	<p>A two day preparatory meeting is planned to take place in October.</p>
<p>TIME INVOLVEMENT AND TRAINER FEES</p>	<p>The selected trainers are expected to participate in the preparation meeting of two working days and to come one day before the participants to the course venue to ensure last-minute preparations.</p> <p>The trainers are also expected to contribute to the final report of the course according to the general SALTO requirements (contributing methods used during the event to the SALTO toolbox (SALTO website under http://www.salto-youth.net/toolbox/).</p> <p>Each trainer will receive a fee of €240 for a total of 8 days.</p>
