#### SALTO-YOUTH ...

... stands for 'Support and Advanced Learning & Training Opportunities within the YOUTH in Action programme'. It is a network of eight Resource Centres to enhance the implementation of the YOUTH in ACTION programme by providing support, information and training to National Agencies (NA) and EuroMed Youth Units (EMYU).

#### EuroMed Resource Centre supports euro-mediterranean cooperation through 5 major axes

#### 1. Training Opportunities
