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4. INFORMATION on SALTO EECA RC

1. OUTLOOK on previous activities co-organised by SALTO EECA

1.1 EECA participants at SOHO Training Course, Reims, France, 22-26 October 2008

For the first time, SALTO Eastern Europe and Caucasus supported SOHO (Sending Organisation, Hosting Organisation) - European module Training Course for EVS Coordinators and Mentors.

Mentors and coordinators of EVS projects play a crucial role in the triangle of Sending Organisations, Host Organisations, and the volunteer. At a SOHO training course, mentors and coordinators from sending and host organisations meet in a multilateral context to exchange needs and expectations and to learn about quality aspects of EVS projects.

On an annual basis, SALTO Training and Co-operation co-ordinates and monitors several SOHO training courses for ca. 250 mentors from all over Europe. The training courses are hosted by the National Agencies of Youth in Action Programme and are implemented by a trainers pool consisting of 7 European trainers.

In 2008 SALTO EECA sent 4 youth workers from EECA region to the event in France.

In 2009 we plan to send several EECA EVS projects coordinators and mentors to SOHO Trainings in Finland (in February) and Turkey (in May).

1.2 Good Practice Event "Tool Fair 3", La Palma, Spain, 5-9 November 2008

Following the frank success of the two past editions of this large event, the SALTO EuroMed together with other SALTO Resource Centres organised the third edition of the "Tool Fair".

Almost 100 people from both Programme and Partner countries arrived safely to Canary Islands, to beautiful town of La Palma.

In one place, for 5 days, the Fair was a **"showroom"** for the huge variety and richness of **tools** developed and used under the **Youth in Action programme**, a place **to experiment with methods and exercises** used within the different actions (youth exchanges, EVS, youth initiatives, training) and based on different themes (cultural diversity, inclusion, cooperation with partner countries, etc...). The Fair helped participants to learn about each other work methods and enabled their tools to be disseminated and hopefully exploited in the future.

2.1 EECA Multipliers Meeting, Tbilisi, Georgia, 17-22 February 2009

Thirty One EECA Multipliers are going to gather again on annual meeting of the network. Main aims of the meeting are to overview the multipliers activities, evaluate 2008 outcomes and prepare work plans for 2009.

SALTO Training and Cooperation is going to use the opportunity of the gathering and disseminate information about YouthPass situation in Eastern Europe and Caucasus on a very practical level. Moreover the representation from European Commission is expected.

SALTO EECA Multipliers Network in Brief

The network of SALTO EECA Multipliers was created in 2004 in order to support the development of the YOUTH Programme in the Region as well as to increase its visibility and quality of realised YOUTH projects in Eastern European and Caucasian Countries. Study visits' objectives are:

- to learn about youth policies in Belarus;
- to share experiences and practices between participants home countries and participants from Belarus;
- to foster mutual knowledge and understanding between participants from different countries involved
- to promote sustainable contacts between the youth NGOs aiming at future development of projects within the Youth in Action Programme

2.3 SOHO Training Course, Turkey, 26-31 May 2009

Deadline for applications: 1 April!

The SOHO training supports voluntary as well as full-time youth workers dealing directly with young volunteers in Sending and Host Organisations as a mentor or coordinator and having little or no experience in long-term volunteering but being at least in the process of starting an European Voluntary Service project (EVS is Action 2 of Youth in Action programme).

This training will go deeper into subjects that are closely linked to EVS. It intends to contribute to an increase in quality of EVS projects. The main subjects of the training are:

- The role of a mentor and coordinator in an EVS project.
- The intercultural dimension of an EVS project.
- Partnerships in EVS.

The methodology used in this training is based on experiential learning and learning-by-doing. Work methods are dynamic, and the participants will be participating actively.

3. Info desk

3.1 II Georgian Youth Organisations Forum took place in Tbilisi, 13-14 December, 2008.

Forum was organised by the Georgian multipliers of the Youth in Action Programme (www.salto-youth.net/eecamultipliers) from Academy for Peace and Development, Youth Association "Droni" and Association "Atinati" in the cooperation with Charity Humanitarian Center "Abkhazeti" and National Council of Youth Organisations of Georgia.

The Georgian Youth Organisations Forum brought together about 100 workers from youth organisations, local and national authorities, youth policy specialists and national and/or international foundations members. The Forum gathered youth organisations in order to share their experiences, but the main focus was made on presenting good practices of youth policy developments in Europe and plans for youth policy development in Georgia. The European Community of the Youth in Action Programme as well as the youth policy of the Council of Europe were presented and discussed during the Forum's sessions.

As an outcome of the Georgian Youth Organisations Forum, a final report of Georgian Youth Organisations will be published in both languages Georgian and English. It will describe briefly the work of the organisations, which took part in the Forum and the outcomes of the debates and presentations.

3.2 EVS position in Russia (Voronezh region) in environmental project.

With this project "Passage-Zebra" (www.workcamps.ru) wants to attract local volunteers to the unique heritage of the region and to raise the consciousness of local inhabitants in their relations to the surrounding environment.

The project will run in the most beautiful place of the Black Earth region – in the open air museum and natural preserve Divnogorje (www.divnogor.ru), which can be translated as "Wonder Mountains".

Tasks for voluntary work:

- work on environmental issues (creative solution of rubbish problem, deleting useless plants, planting useful plants, cleaning, cutting woods). Attention! The work can be physically hard!!!
- work on promotion of ecological values, social work (actions for visitors and locals, building signs for tourists, seminars/workshops for guests on big events and festivals in Divnogorye)
- work on multiplication of effects (web-site update, articles to newspapers, interviews to local TV, meetings with students)
