AIMS OF THE TRAINING COURSE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing a deeper understanding of the philosophy and key quality elements of the European Voluntary Service programme; • Promoting a good understanding in particular of the learning process (of the volunteer and the host organisation) as an important quality element in in EVS projects; • Learning about how to set up a learning environment for volunteers in EVS projects; • Exploring how to create and implement an effective involvement of the volunteer in the host organisation and general working environment, which is beneficial for all the partners; • Learning about key competences and how to implement Youthpass.

TRAINER PROFILE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sound knowledge about the European Voluntary Service of the Youth in Action Programme, its philosophy and practice; • Expertise on issues related to learning in EVS projects, in view of reaching the objectives of the training course (as described above); • Knowledge about / experience in using key competences and implementing Youthpass in EVS; • Experience in using methods that can be used to create self-responsibility and to stimulate ideas, discussion and plans for the future; • Overall trainer skills with regard to working with groups in non-formal educational and youth work settings;
