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1. OUTLOOK on previous activities co-organised by SALTO EECA

1.1 Study visit "Youth work reality in Austria and Belgium", 22-29 March

It's first time when SALTO Eastern Europe and Caucasus Resource Centre (SALTO EECA) together with Austrian and Belgian (French speaking community) National Agencies of the Youth in Action Programme invited 24 active youth workers and youth leaders from the Eastern Europe and Caucasus countries to Austria and Belgium to:

- learn about youth policies in both hosting countries;
- share experiences and practices between hosting countries participants and Eastern Europe and Caucasus participants;
- foster mutual knowledge and understanding between participants from different countries involved
- promote sustainable contacts between the youth NGOs aiming at future development of projects within the Youth in Action Programme

1.2 Seminar in Moscow and Youth Forum in Nizhny Novgorod, Russia, April

In the end of April 2009 representatives of SALTO EECA Resource Centre visited two activities organised by Russian youth organisations:

- 20-26 April: International Youth forum "Youth actions – step by step to the future" in Nizhny Novgorod organised by Interregional Youth Social Movement "Sfera" (www.dobrovolets.ru) with support of European Council
- 23-26 April: Seminar in frames of "Social Diplomatic Corps" long-term course in Moscow organised by National Youth Council of Russia (www.youthrussia.ru) with support of national governmental bodies.

Thanks to the visits, SALTO EECA could gain very valuable knowledge of the youth work in Russian Federation and manage stronger relations between our Resource Centre and different actors in the field of youth policy in Russia.

1.4 Action 2 and 3.1 in EECA region - analysis and statistics from 2008

In the beginning of 2009 we managed to prepare an analysis of action 2 (European Voluntary Service) and 3.1 (Youth Exchanges, Training&Networking) implementation in EECA region. For the first time we were able to compare the data with information collected in previous year and to have possibility to compare it and see trends and changes in "Youth in Action" Programme activities in/with EECA countries.

Among all different outcomes, we would like to share with you that:

- growth of granted EVS activities hosted in Programme Countries with volunteers from EECA region is about **87%** (from 147 activities granted in 2007 to 275 activities in 2008);
- the growth of hosting EVS activities in EECA countries is about **65%** (from 120 activities granted in 2007 to 198 in 2008);
- the growth of the activities in Action 3.1 is about **4%** (small growth of the number of activities within Action 3.1 is connected first of all with NAs' budgetary limits).

Please remember, that the factual quantitative data might slightly be different from those presented in the analysis. The number of factors and data sources makes it very difficult to receive the final numbers.

2. UPCOMING activities

2.1 Seminar on Youth Policy development in EECA region, Konstancin-Warsaw, Poland, 6-9 July

NO call for participants, event by invitations

In July SALTO EECA together with the Partnership Programme between the European Council and the European Commission will organise a seminar about Youth Policy in Eastern Europe and Caucasus to:

- gather key stakeholders of the youth field and youth policy from the EECA region and some CoE and EU experts and to exchange information and views on the status and developments of youth policy in the region, in activities of the Council of Europe youth sector and the initiatives of the European Commission
- to discuss the potential fields of future cooperation, that would be of most added value to all sides.

This is already second meeting of similar format. This year we put stronger focus on gathering representatives of all 3 elements of the youth policy triangle: youth policy makers, youth workers and researchers of youth field.

There will be report published after the seminar, so follow our news!

2.2 Call for Participants for "Let's evaluate with our Neighbours" Seminar, Konstancin-Warsaw, Poland, 6-10 October

In upcoming October three regional SALTOs together with its supporting National Agencies will realise a third stage of "Let's..." activities. After "Let's meet..." and "Let's work..." we will have "Let's evaluate with our Neighbours" evaluation seminar of projects realised in frames of Youth in Action (YiA) Programme in cooperation between partners from three neighbouring regions: Eastern Europe and Caucasus, South East Europe and Euromed as well as Programme Countries.

Main objectives of this year seminar are:

- to promote the QUALITY in cooperation with the Neighbouring Partner Countries (NPC) by evaluation/research of results,
- to collect, highlight and disseminate good practices,
- to evaluate cooperation between youth organisations by presenting good practices and sharing experiences,
- to create a kind of a 'List of recommendations' for future project partners and coordinators,
- additionally to evaluate the cooperation between National Agencies' officers responsible for NPC, regional SALTOs and EC
