### Report based on the evaluation questionnaire for participants

#### **Highlights:**

Most of the participants expressed satisfaction about the training course. Almost all of them gave very positive comments to the trainers and the methods they used. Also, the comunnication during group work was rated as very good. A couple of participants mentioned the platform as a very good tool for spreading information and the methods which were used for getting to topics (games) very interesting and useful. The training increased the participants chances for partnerships. The welcome evening was pointed out as a good opportunity to meet each other in an informal way. Overall, the remarks were mostly positive, both professionally and personally, and the results as productive to take back home and implement locally.


#### **Critical points:**


Regarding the critique that was given to the event, one participant noticed that the group work could have been more controlled for better efficiency, and that the sessions were at times too fast to follow for some of the participants. It was also mentioned that the pre-departure information was sent too late and that it was also too informative which resulted with some of the sessions being "boring". One person pointed out that there were not enough informal activities for the participants to get to know each other.


