- Planning and implementation of information and visibility measures, including on the SALTO-YOUTH website and social media;
- Cooperation with and support to stakeholders' projects, and implementation of stakeholder meetings and events.

What you will bring with you:

- At least an undergraduate degree in a relevant discipline or comparable job experience;
- · Comprehensive knowledge and practical experience with European youth work and youth work practices in Europe;
- Knowledge of Erasmus+: Youth in Action and European Solidarity Corps;
- Extensive competences in the area of non-formal training and educational support in youth work, and of competence development in youth work;
- Solid experience of managing training activities and other events at the European level;
- Very good conceptual, analytical and organisational skills; administrative skills;
- · Experiences with online databases and with IT tools for learning;
- · Proactive approach, capacity to work independently and with others, flexibility, curiosity;
- Very good communication and teamwork related competences;
- Excellent communication and writing skills in English, at least basic skills in German;
- Motivation and competences to work internationally, readiness to go on missions on a regular basis.

We offer:

- A full-time position that follows the regulations of the German Collective Labour Agreement for the Civil Service (TVöD Bund);
- A contract which is, due to the duration of the Erasmus+ programme, initially limited until 31.12.2020, but which is foreseen to be prolonged in case of the next phase of Erasmus+ 2021-2027;
- Remuneration according to the salary group 11 of the German public service (TVöD Bund);
- The possibility for an additional corporate pension provision and for a reduced public transport ticket (Jobticket);
- Flexible working time system that supports individual responsibility for the tasks that will be shaped by personal commitment and creativity;
- · Work in a European context, in a committed team and a dynamic organisation with an open communication culture.
