# 3.3 Call for participants in the Training for the YOUTH Trainers on cooperation with EECA Region; Part I: Lviv, Ukraine, 25-31st August 2006; Part II: Strasburg, France, 11-17th November 2006

#### 4. Latest developments in the SALTO EECA and the youthNET/CIS work

### 4.1 Contact-Making Seminar Yth2 on EVS in cooperation with Eastern Europe and the Caucasus, Poronin, Poland, 1-5th April, 2006

This event brought together 17 Participants: 8 from Programme countries (Portugal, Germany, Spain, Lithuania, Poland, France and Belgium) and 9 from Partner Countries (Russia, Georgia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Ukraine). The group consisted of voluntary and professional youth workers, youth leaders and project coordinators working directly with young people.

During the Seminar, participants had the possibility to develop contacts between European and EECA organisations for future co-operation within the framework of EVS.

The main goals of the CMS were to train participants from both Partner and Programme countries in the necessary technical elements for organising EVS co-operation with EECA countries; to build successful partnerships and intercultural understanding between East and West; to stimulate an understanding and to promote the idea of EVS in EECA countries; and to promote cooperation with the EECA region in the Programme countries.

#### 4.2 Training Course EASTERN EXPRESS, Antalya, Turkey, 11 - 17 May 2006

The EASTERN EXPRESS TC was organised by SALTO EECA, in cooperation with the Turkish YOUTH National Agency, for the benefit of potential partners for Action 1 - Youth Exchange projects within the framework of the YOUTH programme's International Cooperation strand. It focused on the development of cooperation between Programme and Eastern Europe and Caucasus countries. In addition to facilitating and enhancing cooperation between organisations from EECA and Programme countries, the TC also stimulated the creation of new youth exchange project ideas as well as focusing on quality project management skills.

### 4.3 Contact Seminar/International Public Fair: "Inclusion through Art" Wrocław, Poland, 22 -28 May 2006

The main aim of the seminar was to promote international youth work as an extra tool for inclusion of young people into society. The focus of the seminar was using artistic methods in order to reach youth on the edge of society. The Contact Making Seminar had focused on

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Action 1 (Youth Exchange) and Action 5 (Support Measures) of the YOUTH Programme of the European Commission. 29 participants from 14 different countries participated in this event.

Objectives:

- to exchange ideas, methods and good practice in the work field of the participants,
- to initiate long term cooperation between represented organisations by setting up common projects,
- to increase knowledge of realities and cultural understanding between Eastern and Western European citizens,
- to promote the YOUTH Programme as a tool for inclusion.

The International Fair "Inclusion though Art" was a public, open air event in the city centre of Wrocław, where 30 organisations from the seminar and 20 local organisations presented actively their methods of work to the local youth and to each other. The event attracted more than 100 representatives of youth NGOs and lots of curious people from Wrocław!

## 5.1 Training of Trainers and Youth Workers: "Developing Educational Activities for Conflict Resolution", Romania, 13-22 August 2006

A training course dedicated to less experienced trainers and youth workers from all YOUTH programme countries as well as from Eastern Europe and the Caucasus, who are carrying out intercultural youth activities. The aims of the training course are:

- To provide basic insight into different concepts of learning in non-formal education.
- To increase the participants' competencies and motivation to introduce and deal with intercultural learning in their activities.

The specific objectives of this project are as follows:

- During the training course the participants will gain skills and competencies to design, run, and evaluate youth activities.
- By the end of the training course the participants will learn 25 methods and techniques used in youth work.
- The participants will get familiar with the characteristics of the youth sector for a better understanding of methods and techniques.
- The participants will increase their knowledge and awareness of the values of nonformal education in youth activities.

#### 5.5 "TOOL FAIR", France, 1-5 November 2006

The "Tool Fair" will gather 120 people coming from both programme and partner countries, all stakeholders of the YOUTH programme: young people, youth workers, trainers, etc.

In one place, for 3 days, the Fair will be a "showroom" for the huge variety and richness of tools developed and used under the YOUTH programme, a place to experiment with methods and exercises used within the different actions (youth exchanges, EVS, youth initiatives, training) and based on different themes (cultural diversity, inclusion, cooperation with partner countries, etc...). The Fair could become the creation of the participants themselves and enable their tools to be used throughout the programme. "Savoir-faire" will be gathered in order to create a "common memory".

### 6.1 Youth Exchange: "Youth for Peace Between the Cultures", Georgia, 4-11 May 2006

The Youth Exchange gathered together young people from seven countries (four from each country plus one group leader) in Kobuleti, Georgia. A total of 40 participants spent 8 days together in order to get to know peace building methods, obstacles, experiences and knowledge relating to conflict resolution techniques.
