## What is TICTAC?

TICTAC TC is designed for **youth workers** and **youth leaders** who have experienced an international event/activity (not necessarily under the YiA) coming from organisations that have the will to **develop action 4.3 & 3.1 projects** within a long term strategy.

This space for self-assessment is also linked with the concrete application of their new competences in their own realities through building a learning diary and a personal action plan.

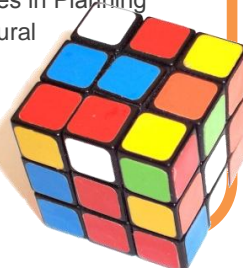
## The aim and objectives of TICTAC

The **overall aim** of the TICTAC TC is:

To develop participants' competences for implementing Action 4.3 & 3.1 projects, as support measures in an organization's long term strategy.

The **specific objectives** of the course are:

- To promote the YiA Programme as an Educational Tool;
- To explore the YiA Programme with a special focus on the aims of Action 4.3 and its activities;
- To understand the role of Action 4.3 & 3.1 projects within a long term strategy;
- To simulate the first steps of organising an Action 4.3 & 3.1 project within an international team;
- To develop participant's competences in Planning Non Formal Education and Intercultural Learning Processes;
- To promote Youth Participation and European Citizenship as key elements when designing a YiA Project;



*Links with Youth in Action*

TICTAC TC presents the YiA as a whole, this means that a special attention is given to the programme priorities and features and the correlation between the different actions when designing a long term strategy in Youth Work.

Through the TICTAC TC process, participants will be challenged to reflect upon the role of young people in the project development, and the impacts of their projects and activities regarding the promotion of Active Citizenship.

TICTAC TC uses a 3-day simulation exercise in which participants go through a project cycle within international teams. Participants will also assess each other's projects according to the quality aspects and rules of YiA. This exercise also aims to clarify the roles of NAs' and advisory commissions as well as the quality criteria's of a YiA project.
