What Is Cyberspace?

Cyberspace is a **virtual space** where lots of different types of information is shared and stored over the **internet**.





What Is Cyberspace?

People can connect to cyberspace at any time any place anywhere once they are connected to the internet.





What Is Cyberspace?

You can go on cyberspace with a **computer** or a **laptop** or a **tablet** or a **gaming console** or a **mobile or amazon echo Alexia – talking speaker that plays music – you can ask Alexia questions also**






What Is the Internet?

The internet is the worlds largest network of computers that are connected to each other all over the planet.

It is connected by a wire or over Wi-Fi. Wi-fi is invisible signals that are sent by tall masts to your internet devices.

You can listen to music, watch films, play games and search for things.






What Is the Internet?



- Cyber bullying is when a person or group of people use the internet and mobile phones to threaten, tease or upset someone else
- Cyber bullying can make us feel sad or frightened or scared





Cyber bullying is **different** from other types of bullying because it can happen when someone is at home rather than at school or college or work or in the street



You might also not know who is bullying you because a cyber bully can hide who they are







How do I know if cyber bullying is happening to me?





How do you know?

- Someone can send nasty or abusive emails to you
- Someone could use online chat rooms to threaten you or say nasty things about you
- Someone could use social networking sites like Facebook and Twitter to write nasty and upsetting comments about you
- Someone could send abusive text messages or video message to you on your mobile phone
- Someone could spread rumours about you on social media
- Some could post a horrible picture of you online





How do you know?

- Stealing a persons account information to break into their account to send damaging messages to their friends
- Sexting or sending sexual pictures or messages about a person
- Tricking someone into sharing secrets and then spreading the information around
- Excluding someone from online social groups





SEXTING

Sexual harassment or "sexting" without permission: Happens when a person harasses another in order to share erotic or sexual contents without his/her permission.

Never share your passwords either!




Dangers - Logging Off and Private/Public

- Look out for the https: on website addresses.
- Never enter your personal details into a website unless the URL starts with HTTPS.
- S stands for Secure. It means that you can safely use your debit or credit card on that website.
- If there is a lock in the address bar it means that it is safe.
