AUDIT - CITY, COMPANY, ORGANISATION

Main aim of this activity is to encourage discussion and sharing on various aspects of the environment and sustainability. The activity can be adjusted to the needs of cities, companies or small organisations. It can be realized individually, in pairs or in groups.

We realized this activity during an international event implemented within the project 'Nature the Youth Work'. In our workshop, the participants worked in their national teams and reflected on their cities such as Gyumri (Armenia), Kobuleti (Georgia), Prerov (Czechia), and Vranje (Serbia).

After working in the national groups, the participants presented their audits and discussed the most appealing environmental and sustainability issues.

Materials: Each participant or group should have a copy of the audit. We are aware that not all questions are relevant to all cities or organisations thus the participants can adjust them, or they can also include questions related to the issues that they feel that they are missing.

About the project: The project "Nature the Youth Work", 2023-3-CZ01-KA153-YOU-000175863 aims to explore new ways of bringing ecological and environmental issues into the youth work and communities. AUDIT - Dining/kitchen

Can the standby mode of appliances be controlled centrally?
Are there sensor-controlled lights in less frequently used areas, e.g., in restrooms?
Is your television and video equipment completely turned off, or are they in standby mode?
What room temperature is it set to?
How do you keep coffee or tea warm?
How much water do you use to flush toilets? (economy mode)
How mach water do you use to hush tollets: (economy mode)



AUDIT - Raising & Training

Are there any training courses on sustainability?
Does anyone take care of sustainability at events?
Are there any established indicators and measurements related to sustainability?
Do you track the development of knowledge and attitudes regarding sustainability?
Do you collaborate with any non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that focus on
sustainability, environmental issues?
Do you organize joint events?
Are you part of events promoting environmental, ecological issues?
