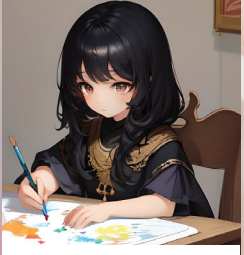

We woke up in the early morning to the sound of bombs coming out of a tank between two fighting sides.



That day instead of bird sounds you could hear people shouting.

The bombs dropped from the tanks targeted people who fell inside the buildings like tree leaves.



Our door was locked from the pressure of the bombs and when my father opened the door,



I was watching people walking on the street being shot by snipers.



That day we were given two hours to get out of the house and save our lives.



That makes us think if they gave us that time to recover or to show us the violence that they had done.



Unfortunately, we came to Turkey with my family because this violence continued.

I am still going to school, and I have learned Turkish. In my free time, I give private lessons and I paint.
