- Padlet is a website and app.
- It lets people share ideas on a digital board.
- You can add text, pictures, links, videos, and more.
- It's like a big online notice board!





Who Can Use Padlet?

- Teachers for lessons and class activities.
- Students for projects and group work.
- Teams for brainstorming and sharing ideas.
- Anyone for personal notes or planning.





Why Use Padlet?

- Easy to use no design skills needed.
- Everything is saved in one place.
- You can work alone or with others.
- Fun and visual way to organize ideas.





Features of Padlet

- Add text, images, videos, and voice recordings.
- Drag and drop posts.
- Choose from different board styles.
- Works on phones, tablets, and computers.





Padlet Board Styles

- Wall posts in a grid
- Stream posts in a line
- Shelf posts under topics
- Map share locations
- Timeline events in order





How to Use Padlet

- Step by Step

- Go to <u>www.padlet.com</u>
- Sign up or log in
- Click "+ Make a Padlet"
- Choose a board style
- Give it a name and description
- Start posting!



How to Add Posts

- Click the + button or double-click the board.
- Type your message.
- Add files, links, or images if you like.
- Click Publish/Post.





Sharing Your Padlet

- Click "Share" to:
- Invite friends or students
- Create a link
- Post to Google Classroom or Microsoft Teams
- · You can control who can see or edit it.

- Paid: More boards, extra storage, and features
