


## HOW TO PLAY?



1. Choose your avatar

4. Face the challenge




**You laugh at a stereotype in a meme and forward it to your friends.**

Lose 1 point – stereotypes hurt.



**You participate in a peace walk on Human Rights Day.**

Gain 2 points!



**You teach someone how to say “thank you” in your language.**

Gain 1 point for cultural exchange.







**You stay silent when someone makes a racist comment.**

Lose 1 point – silence can be complicity.



**You post an inspirational message about equality on social media.**

Gain 1 point – your voice matters!



**You refuse to play with someone because of their clothes.**

Lose 2 points – that's discrimination.



**You invite someone from another country to your birthday party.**

Gain 1 point for being inclusive!



**You create a poster promoting diversity in your school.**

Gain 2 points and inspire others.



**You throw trash in the street instead of a bin.**

Lose 1 point – the environment suffers.



**You are invited to dinner at a Turkish friend's house and notice everyone takes off their shoes at the door.**

You do the same and ask about the tradition. Gain 2 points for respect and curiosity!



**You meet a Cypriot student who speaks both Greek and Turkish.**

You ask how they switch between languages. Gain 2 points for appreciating multilingualism!



**You see an Italian friend greeting others with two kisses on the cheek.**

You feel awkward but try to follow. Gain 1 point for being open to new customs!





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
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**During a French exchange program, lunch lasts 2 hours. You're surprised by the long meal.**

Reflect on the cultural differences around food and time. Gain 1 point for cultural awareness!



**A Belgian classmate brings waffles with a strange topping. You hesitate to try.**

You give it a chance and love it. Gain 2 points for trying new things!



**Your Spanish host family eats dinner at 10 PM. You find it odd.**

You adapt and ask why schedules are different. Gain 2 points for flexibility!



**A friend from Turkey invites you to a religious celebration. You're not sure what to expect.**

You ask questions and participate respectfully. Gain 3 points for cultural participation!



**You share your country's traditional music, and others share theirs.**

You enjoy the mix of rhythms and instruments. Gain 2 points for cultural exchange!



**You accidentally offend someone by making assumptions about their culture.**

You apologize and ask how to do better. Gain 2 points for humility and learning!



**You meet someone from another country who doesn't eat the same food as you for religious reasons.**

You ask respectfully about their diet. Gain 2 points for intercultural respect!



**You teach someone how to say "hello" in your language, and they teach you theirs.**

A simple exchange becomes a fun learning moment. Gain 1 point for language curiosity!



**You mispronounce someone's name from another country.**

You ask how to say it correctly. Gain 1 point for respect!





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
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You hear two people arguing about which culture is "better."

You step in and suggest learning from both. Gain 2 points for promoting understanding!



You watch a film from a European country you've never visited.

It shows daily life and traditions unfamiliar to you. Gain 1 point for cultural insight!

You ask about its meaning and offer to adjust the meeting schedule. Gain 3 points for inclusivity!



You receive an Erasmus+ scholarship to study abroad.

Gain +3 points – Your European adventure begins!



A train strike in France delays your trip.

Gain 0 points – You arrive late and tired.



You take part in a cultural exchange in Belgium and make new friends.

Gain +2 points – Friendship has no borders!



You accidentally insult someone in Italy by using the wrong gesture.

Gain 0 points – Oops! Time to learn the culture better.



You win a prize in a European youth art contest.

Gain +2 points – Your creativity shines!



You misunderstand a joke in another language and feel awkward.

Gain 0 points – Language learning takes time.







**A friend from another country invites you to their national holiday celebration.**

Gain +2 points – You feel part of something bigger.



**You post a stereotype online and get called out.**

Gain 0 points – Think before you post.



**You learn to cook a traditional French dish with a local family.**

Gain +2 points – Delicious culture!



**Your flight to an EU youth event is cancelled.**

Gain 0 points – You miss the opportunity.



**You help translate for someone struggling with the local language.**

Gain +2 points – Communication builds bridges.



**You take part in a European Youth Parliament simulation.**

Gain +3 points – Democracy in action!



**Your social media post about a cultural event goes viral.**

Gain +1 point – Awareness spreads fast!



**You volunteer at a refugee center in Cyprus.**

Gain +3 points – Solidarity makes Europe stronger.



**Heavy snow in Spain cancels a school event.**
