

## ***NEVER FORGET ME!***

**Material** – N/A

**Target Group** – not specific

**Size Group** – from 8 up to 40 persons

**Duration** – Depends of the Size of the group, but normally for 20 persons it takes 25m

### **Development**

1- Divide the group in different subgroups with 4/5 persons each (find a creative way to do it). Explain them that a lot persons with different names made History from the beginning of Humanity until today. Some of them we still remember the names, other ones, unfortunately, we just have contact with what they have been creating, developing, building, etc...

2 – the task you request for each subgroup, it's to develop a CREATIVE PRESENTATION which will introduce the names of all elements of the subgroup, BUT with one REMARK: WE CAN'T NEVER FORGET!! (could be a theatre performance, a creative arrangement with the letter of the names, could be a music, etc... ). 7/8 minutes for the subgroups prepare the presentation it's more than enough.

3 – After each Presentation the trainer/facilitator must remember all the names presented during the performance and ask for each participant if the name they all introduce it's the one S/he wants to be called (some of them have nick names or shortly names that they feel more comfortable to be called!).

NOTE – After all presentation the trainer/facilitator could give the positive reinforcement (mostly for group which you expect to build partnerships) tell that "if you can do such a creative and effective presentation together in 7/8 minutes, imagine after this TC/seminar/Meeting?!).

This Activity works well for icebreaking and getting know better the participants, and for the trainer could have the first contact with the creativity of the group and how they can work in group together.
