## CONTEXT

Conflict contexts have been developed (gender-based, racial and ethnic, religious, disablism, homophobia, romaphobia, xenophobia, nationalism) affecting mostly the disadvantaged and marginalized groups of children and young people.

Conflict Management and Peaceful Transformation of Conflict are priority issues for young people, youth leaders and youth workers from South-Eastern Europe. Learning how to deal and how to react to different conflicts in a peaceful and efficient way can give young people the opportunity to develop on a personal and professional level, but, in the same time, can change different conflict situations and mentalities in their own communities.

### The training will take place in the framework of the new "All Different - All Equal" Campaign

"All different, All equal" is the call of the Council of Europe for Diversity, Human Rights and Participation.

In 1995 - 50 years after the end of World War II - the Council of Europe ran a European Youth Campaign entitled "All Different - All Equal" in order to reinforce the fight against racism, anti-Semitism, Xenophobia and Intolerance.

Nevertheless the struggle - 10 years afterwards - still goes on. For this reason, from June 2006 to September 2007, the Council of Europe will run a new Campaign for Diversity, Human Rights and Participation, based upon the same slogan and using the same successful logo.

The 2006-2007 Campaign is being organised in partnership with the European Commission and the European Youth Forum.

## MAIN GOAL

To train young people, youth leaders, youth workers and NGO representatives to act as Peace Educators in their own organisations and communities, at local and regional level.

## OBJECTIVES

- to develop the participants' personal skills, knowledge and attitudes to act as Peace Educators;
- to acknowledge and recognize the importance of peace education in addressing all forms of violence;
- to introduce the "All Different - All Equal" campaign as a key point in shaping activities to promote peace and combat violence, at a local and regional level;
- to train the participants in applying non-formal education for peace instruments

## METHODOLOGY

The training will contain various methods and activities specific to non-formal education.

The Training will focus on different methods using non-formal education in working with key concepts.

During the Training the participants will be able to deepen their knowledge using different concepts, approaching different topics and learning different competences.

Also, the methodological approach of the training will focus on **team work** and **learning by experience** working methods.

The participants will have the chance to experience different situations (out-door activities, simulation games, working in teams, workshops, role plays etc.) and to create or reshape different working tools by actively using them in their own team workshops during the training.
