- aged 18 years or older
- residents of the Youth in Action Programme Countries (27 EU countries + Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Turkey), EECA and SEE regions (there are four places for participants from EECA and SEE countries)
- ready for ACTIVE participation in the whole training
- who would like to change something in their work/organization/group

The training course will be held on **7-12 December 2009** in **Poland.** Participants are expected to arrive on the 7^{th} in the evening; departures are planned on the 12^{th} after breakfast.
