#### Bring an unemployed young person!

A <u>young person</u> (< 26) from your project is invited to attend the parallel youth seminar on employment. Give them the chance to:

- Exchange experiences with other unemployed youth
- Develop strategies to work on their employability
- Give their opinion to improve employment projects
- Practice their English (basic English required)
- Have fun and get an international boost to get a job

Note: The programme for unemployed young people & their coaches starts already on 17 October afternoon to allow more time for group building.

Coaches/workers in youth employment projects are invited to <u>apply online</u> for both yourself and one unemployed young person. If selected, SALTO Inclusion will pay for your travel, hotel & food.
