

## CALL FOR A TRAINER

### Training Course “Cherry on the cake” – Youth exchange in the context of a long-term work with groups of young people

Zavod MOVIT, the Slovenian National Agency for the Erasmus+ Programme in the field of youth, and SALTO South East Europe Resource Centre are looking for a trainer for a training course “Cherry on the cake” – Youth exchange in the context of a long-term work with groups of young people.

<p><b>Target group and the aim of the activity</b></p>	<p>The training course is for organisations from the Erasmus+ Programme Countries and the Western Balkan region (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro and Serbia) working with groups of young people on a regular basis.</p> <p>The focus of the activity is on quality planning of all phases of a Youth Exchange (planning, compilation, preparation,, implementation, closing and dissemination), within the Erasmus+ Programme’s Key Action 1, with the emphasis on careful planning of learning goals designed specifically for young people involved. The aim is to support the participating organisations to use a Youth Exchange as a tool and motivational factor in their regular long-term work with groups of young people.</p> <p>The training course will be developed upon a series of training courses on the same topic implemented in the national level in Slovenia in 2012 – 2014. (A publication based on the training courses was published in 2014. It is available in Slovene language at <a href="http://www.mva.si/erasmus-mladi-v-akciji/publikacije/">http://www.mva.si/erasmus-mladi-v-akciji/publikacije/</a> .) The established module will be extended and further developed to correspond to the needs of international target groups.</p>
<p><b>Tasks for the trainer</b></p>	<p>The selected trainer will develop and implement the programme of activities for the training course jointly with a co-trainer Sašo Kronegger <a href="https://www.salto-youth.net/tools/toy/saso-kronegger.2317/">https://www.salto-youth.net/tools/toy/saso-kronegger.2317/</a>, who has been involved in the development of the national training courses and the related publication. The team of trainers will work in close consultation with the organisers. The trainers are also expected to prepare a report for the activity, containing information on the background of the activity, aim and objectives, implemented programme of activities with reflection on the outcomes (overall, and session by session) and a summary of the evaluation (both by the team and the participants).</p>

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<p><b>Profile of the trainer and the selection criteria</b></p>	<p>Accordingly, the selected trainer should have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Excellent overall trainer skills with regard to working with international groups in the frame of non-formal education and youth work;</li> <li>• Knowledge and experience in applying a variety of non-formal educational methods in order to reach the specific learning objectives set for the training course as well as to stimulate reflection, sense of initiative and sharing among the participants;</li> <li>• Knowledge / experience of the Erasmus+ Programme and prior experience in the Youth in Action Programme (2007 – 2013), in particular Youth Exchanges;</li> <li>• Experience in youth work in the context of the Western Balkan region;</li> <li>• Practical experience in organising youth exchanges is an asset;</li> </ul> <p>The trainer can be contracted only through a legally established entity (an organisation or a company).</p>
<p><b>Time involvement and fees</b></p>	<p>The activity is foreseen to take place in Slovenia in 3<sup>rd</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> of November 2014. The programme of activities will be consisted of five full working days and the arrival evening prior the first working day.</p> <p>A two day preparatory meeting in foreseen to take place in Slovenia 4<sup>th</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> of September 2014.</p> <p>The fee will be <b><u>2240,00 EUR</u></b></p>
<p><b>Application and recruitment process</b></p>	<p>All applicants must fill in the online application form available at <a href="http://onlineform.salto-youth.net/1268">http://onlineform.salto-youth.net/1268</a> by <b>21<sup>st</sup> of August 2014</b> at the latest. The application requires a registration in the MySALTO system. If the applicant does not have a MySALTO profile yet, the page will direct to the registration.</p> <p>Applicants will be selected on the basis of their competences and suitability for the required tasks, with reference to the selection criteria above. The organisers will give a priority to candidates from the Western Balkan region. The selection results will be communicated to all applicants by <b>25<sup>th</sup> of August 2014</b>.</p>
