Eastern Partnership region

Caucasus: Armenia, Azerbaijan, <u>Georgia</u>

Eastern Europe: Belarus, <u>Moldova, Ukraine</u>

ca. 16 million population with hight rate of youth ca. 55 million population but decreasing

<u>countries</u> that signed association agreement with EU

Russian Federation

83 subjects of the federation: *including 21 autonomous republics*

ca. 144 million population, where 20% are ethnic minorities



Civil societies' development:

- well developed and raising in Georgia and Ukraine
- well developing in Armenia and Moldova
- limited in Azerbaijan, Belarus and Russia

Freedom House index:

- partly free: Armenia, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine
- not free: Azerbaijan, Belarus and Russia









Unemployment is rather low:

- on average 15%
- among youth ca. 30%
- lowest in Russia and Belarus
- highest in Armenia and Moldova

But the average monthly salary remains low:

- ca. 200 euro netto in Azerbaijan, Moldova and Ukraine
- ca. 300 euro netto in Armenia, Georgia and Belarus
- and in Russia ca. 480 euro netto





Conflict zones:

- Nagorno Karabah (Armenia/Azerbaijan)
- South Ossetia (Georgia/Russia)
- Abkhazia (Georgia/Russia)
- Crimea and Donbass (Ukraine/Russia)
- Transnistria (Moldova/Russia)
