Topics

- Exploring occupations, sources, tools;
- Planning your studies;
- Tools used in making a career decision, career planning;
- Looking for a job;
- Personal branding;
- Preparing applications, CVs, motivation letters, portfolio etc;
- Perspectives of employers/employees on the development of young people's careers;
- Challenges and difficulties in the interviewing/applying for a job process etc.

E-book, reflection themes, sharing practices, quizzes etc.

You will need between 1 hour to 20 hours to explore the content of the module depending on your study pace and on what areas you want to discover. You can choose your own study period.
