








E-Active Citizen Citizen Guide

The project main aim is to develop our capacities of enabling young people to become active, responsible citizens and promote participatory democracy by:

- 1. Equipping 30 youth workers with necessary competencies in order to address the democratic disconnect of young people using innovative techniques;
- 2. Identifying and exploiting specific digital media tools which motivate young people to become active citizens;





- 3. Developing specific communication techniques connected to social media societythat inspire young people to become active citizens;
- 4. Sharing effective online tools which will help 10 NGOs to better engage youngpeople in the democratic processes;
- 5. Strengthening 10 partners cooperation through the E+ in the field of democratic participation of youth.
