To explore how film and visual storytelling can serve as educational tools to address discrimination, foster empathy, and inspire dialogue by combining diverse perspectives and creative approaches.



Gain awarness

To raise awareness on the topics of discrimination, prejudice, stereotypes, and social inclusion by increasing competencies of youth workers



GAIN FILMMAKING SKILLS

To equip youth workers with tools and filmmaking materials to gain more trust and competence in using different multimedia tools especially cinema to promote important values in societies

TRAINERS

Michał Bisiorek is a filmmaker, video editor, content creator and social media specialist working in a polish radio station 'Radio 357'. He was a participant of many Erasmus projects, such as Erasmus Student Network, Erasmus+ Youth Exchange and European Solidarity Corps (volunteering in a local TV station 'Offener Kanal" in Magdeburg). He records a music and culture related podcast "BeKwadrat" (in polish) available on Spotify and Apple Music.

Jerry Jachowicz is a filmmaker, psychology graduate, and trainer with a diverse range of experiences. He has directed several short films and participated in film festivals, as well as numerous filmmaking workshops across Poland. He has worked as a filmmaking instructor at a camp in the USA and is currently involved in mental health development workshops for youth in schools, drawing on his background in clinical psychology. His international experience includes participating in Erasmus + projects in Spain, France, and Portugal, along with volunteering and attending thematic workshops while studying abroad.





TRAINERS

Franek Porayski-Pomsta took part in many Erasmus projects among which university exchange, training courses and volounteering projects. In area of education, he gives tutoring lessons in English, polish culture, literature and history. In the past he worked in alternative education organization CEMEA in south of France. After finishing his bachelor in liberal arts, he studies master in interdisciplinary humanities studies on Warsaw University. He focuses on cultural studies, as his thesis depicts cities in polish romcoms.

Katka Schrager is an experienced trainer and a teacher working on a daily basis in Non- Formal Education environment. PIŃCZÓW


You get down on the Minibus Main Station in Pińczów which is located on Legionistów 26 street (right next to the lake). The MAIN BUS STATION is right there.

Pińczów



Pronounced ['pjijtuf] is a town in southern Poland, in Swietokrzyskie Voivodeship. The town was given the city rights in 1428. Pińczów belongs to the historic Polish province of Lesser Poland, and lies in the valley of the Nida river. The town has a station on a narrow-gauge line, called Holy Cross Mountains Rail.

The town's attractions include the 18th-century palace of the Wielopolski family, several churches and monasteries (some dating back to 15th century), the Renaissance St. Anne's Chapel, the recently restored synagogue, and ruins of the 13th-centurycastle.. In Pińczów's district of Mirów there also was a Franciscan monastery, founded in 1587 by Bishop Piotr Myszkowski. In Mirów there is a house which once was a Calvinist printing shop. Now it houses a branch of the National Archive of Poland.


