ABOUT THE PROJECT



Following the high importance of technology in personal and professional life, this training course aims to enable youth workers integrate digital tools into their approach, through non-formal methods. It focuses on the need for youth workers to incorporate AI and other digital aspects into their work, but also to develop the abilities needed to use digital instruments like critical thinking, ability to solve problems and how to effectively check information.

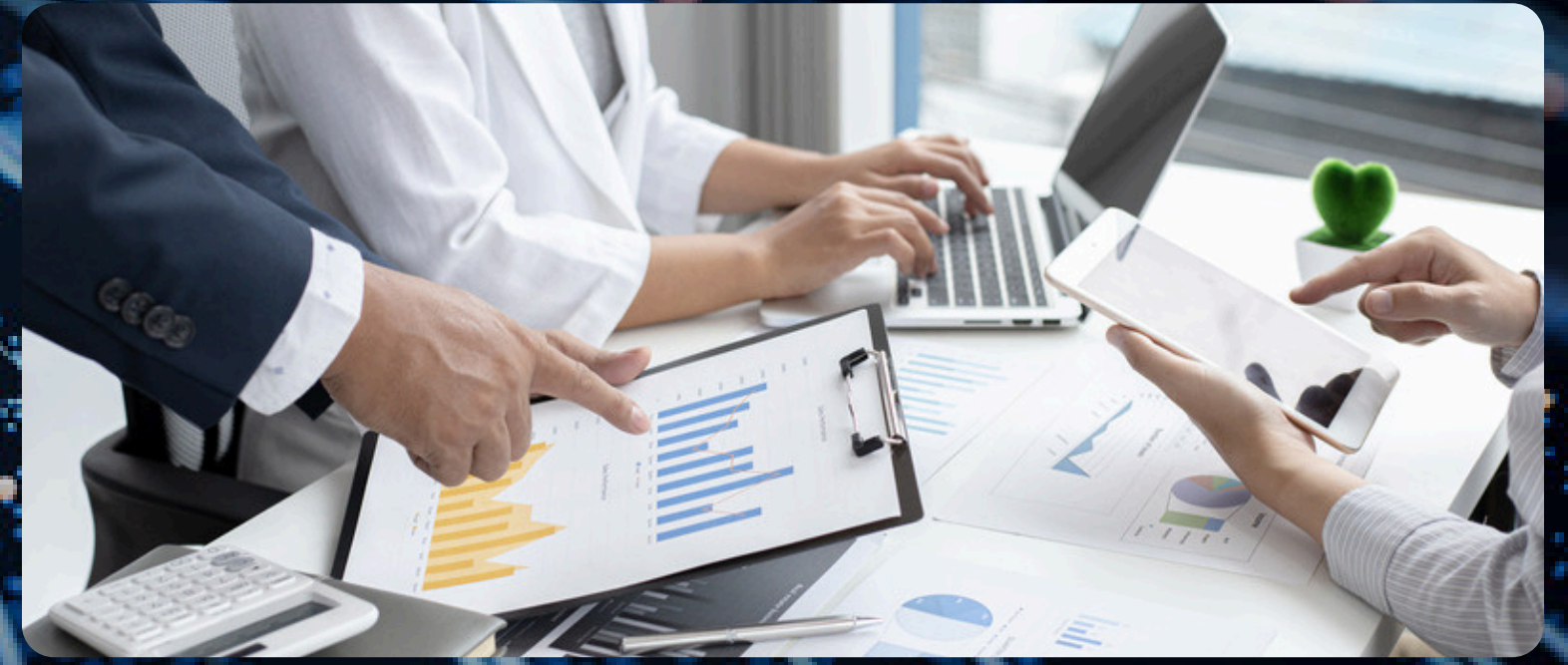
OBJECTIVE
