#### TRAINING COURSE

The Sustainability Competence Training Course is designed to enhance the competencies of youth workers in the field of sustainability, based on the GreenComp EU Sustainability Framework. Participants will gain knowledge, skills, and attitudes in areas such as sustainable development, environmental responsibility, and green transformation.

This unique program aims to equip youth workers with advanced knowledge and skills in sustainability, helping them to lead with environmental and social responsibility.

This innovative training course supports youth workers in acquiring critical skills and advanced technical expertise in sustainability, enabling them to adapt to rapidly changing global environmental conditions. The program is structured around non-formal learning methodologies, combining theoretical knowledge with practical applications. It empowers participants to develop sustainable projects and create meaningful impact in their communities. Additionally, it fosters knowledge exchange and networking through interactions with academics and industry experts from across Europe on the topic of sustainable leadership.

The primary goal of this course is to empower youth workers in sustainable leadership and practices, cultivating leaders who act with environmental and social consciousness.





## **KEY OBJECTIVES FOR PARTICIPANTS**

- Explore sustainable leadership approaches and learn how to effectively implement eco-friendly strategies.
- Develop their sustainability competencies within the GreenComp framework, enabling more informed decisions in ecological awareness and social responsibility.
- Strengthen their ability to design and implement projects aligned with the green economy, environmental policies, and sustainable development goals.
- Enhance their analytical thinking and strategic planning skills for sustainability-focused decision-making processes.
- Learn how to combine team management and communication skills with ecoconscious leadership in diverse social and cultural contexts.
- Gain the ability to develop proactive and innovative solutions to rapidly evolving climate policies and environmental challenges.

By the end of the course, participants will possess advanced knowledge and tools in sustainable leadership, environmental awareness, and green transformation, making sustainability a central pillar in their personal and professional development.

We are seeking youth workers from across Europe who play an active role in sustainability and youth work, are eager to develop innovative solutions, and aspire to lead environmental transformation. This program is specifically designed for leaders aiming to develop sustainability-focused projects and enhance their capacity in this field.

#### **LANGUAGES**

English will be the primary language of instruction for the training course.

Participants should be able to communicate independently in English.

#### PRACTICAL AND FINANCIAL ASPECTS OF PARTICIPATION

The training course will take place on 23<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2025 at Malazgirt, Mus Malazgirt Sultan Alparslan Youth Camp, located in the district center of Malazgirt.

The Malazgirt Sultan Alparslan Youth Camp, newly completed and opening for use for the first time, will provide shared accommodation. Each room contains four beds.

Participants are expected to arrive in Malazgirt on 23<sup>th</sup> of May 2025 and to depart on 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2025, and to attend the full course.


# YOUR GUIDE TO REACHING ACCOMODATION PLACE FROM MUSSULTAN ALPARSLAN AIRPORT (MSR)

There are regular daily flights to Mus from both Istanbul and Ankara. You may plan your trip to Mus with a transfer through either Istanbul or Ankara.

Participants who choose to travel using green transportation options will be highly appreciated and especially rewarded, in alignment with the theme of the training course.

Participants arriving in Mus city center will be picked up and transferred to Malazgirt by the coordinating organization.

The total distance is approximately 130 km, and the journey takes about 1 hour and 50 minutes.



#### **COSTS AND TRAVEL EXPENSES**

Participation is free, and accommodation, meals, and travel expenses will be covered by the organizers.

Travel expenses and visa fees for traveling to Malazgirt will be reimbursed according to the rules of the **Erasmus+ Distance Colculations.** However, only participants who attend all sessions of the training program can be reimbursed.
