# About the project

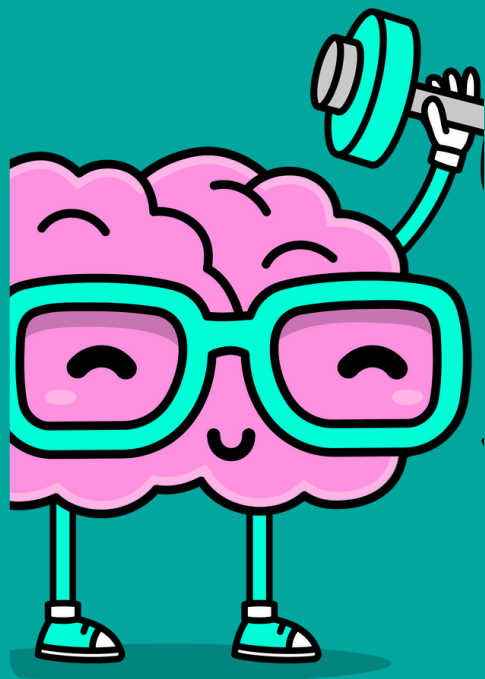


# Participants Profile

The participants involved are youth workers, who work actively with young people, especially those from marginalized groups such as Roma people. They are active in their local environment as well as internationally and need to be trained in creative and digital tools and methods. They are open to developing skills and competencies that will improve their youth work, will help them easily access their target groups and help them to be active citizens.

What we really support is that youth workers are also people coming from different backgrounds and we strongly support youth workers from marginalized groups such as: migrants, LGBTIQ+ community, Roma people. The age is 18+ and the working language is English.

## Important Note



Participants will be required to fully attend the program, to participate actively in the process of creation of new workshops based on the methods learned and materials for dissemination and visibility, as well as actively commit in the dissemination process.

# Accommodation and food



We will stay at KulturHaus in Osterholz-Scharmbeck, near Bremen, Germany. The place is foreseen to be ideal for groups and international projects in the middle of the nature. We will be in 3 and 4 bed rooms with own bathroom. Please bring your toiletries (towel, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, flipflops, hygienic products).

# Travel

- The village where the mobility is taking place is called Garlstedt. The nearest city is Bremen and from Bremen to our venue, you will need to use public transportation (bus number 660)
- The bus departs from bus stop “J” which you can find close to the Bremen train station entrance.
- Our bus stop is called OHZ-GARLSTEDT, BW LOGISTIKSCHULE.
- You should take the last bus from Bremen (at 18:45). Someone from our team will wait for you at the bus stop.
- The ticket costs 6,90 euros and you are buying it from the bus driver. You can pay only in cash so make sure that you have some euros with you
- Only for the ones arriving after 19:00 to Bremen: You will have to take a more complex travel option.

## Travel reimbursement

The reimbursement of the travel costs will be organized in the following steps:

1. Participant search for the most economic and green way of travel and sends the suggestion to the organizers for confirmation
2. Once the organizers confirm, participant buys the tickets
3. In a shared common folder, each participant creates it's own folder with a name and uploads the bought tickets/invoices. Later on the way to the venue all other tickets and boarding passes should be uploaded in the folder. On the way back to home is the same, everything should be uploaded in the folder.
4. When the folder is complete, our administrator contacts the participant for confirmation of the final cost.
5. Once the final cost is confirmed, AmaroDrom e.V. reimburses the travel cost to the bank account provided by the participant.
