About PeaceStage

Main objective:

To strengthen the capacities of participating organizations and youth workers in peacebuilding, conflict prevention, and mediation through specialized theater-based training.

The training will use interactive and reflective methodologies to engage youth in critical dialogue and action, empowering them

to understand structural inequalities and take active roles in advancing the Youth, Peace, and Security agenda within their communities.



Specific Objectives

- To develop participants' understanding of the concepts of community building, creation and sustainability, peace, and human rights at the interpersonal, planetary, and institutional levels.
- To foster participants' capacities to act as community leaders, peacebuilders, and multipliers of inclusive values at local, regional, and European levels.
- To enhance participants' self-reflection and self-assessment skills in their learning

processes and in meaningful cooperation with others, and to enable them to transfer the acquired skills into the educational development of others.

• To develop young people's knowledge of human rights, active citizenship, conflict resolution, communication, and teamwork skills.






EXPECTED OUTCOMES

To create four- five interactive community theatre pieces addressing themes of oppression relevant to Youth, Peace, and Security, such as youth marginalization in decision-making processes, hate speech, discrimination, intersectionality, and intercultural tensions.



WHO IS ORGANIZING THIS TRAINING?




- The training is part of the Erasmus+ accreditation in the Youth program of the International Foundation for Y-PEER Development (IFYD).
- Established in 2016, IFYD builds on the experience of professionals and volunteers from the International Institute for Youth Development PETRI-Sofia (www.petri-sofia.org), which has over 15 years of experience working with young people on topics aligned with the objectives and

priorities of the Erasmus+ program.

• Its interventions aim to train and mentor young people as youth leaders and peer educators, building their capacities in the areas of Intercultural Dialogue, Advocacy for SDG Implementation, Comprehensive Sexuality Education, and Life Skills Education. These efforts target both in-school and out-of-school contexts, with a particular focus on reaching adolescents and youth from low-resource and marginalized backgrounds.

Eligibility & Funding



Target Group: Youth workers and peer educators with no age limit from the following countries: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Germany, Georgia, Greece, Ireland, Jordan, Kosovo, Lebanon, Lithuania, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Palestine, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Turkey, and Ukraine.

Expenses: Travels, and full board accommodation are covered by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union. Please note that health insurance and visa costs are not covered by the project.

Travel expenses are reimbursed on an individual basis based on the submitted invoices. Each participant will receive and sign for reimbursement corresponding to the exact amount spent, up to the specified limit below the table. Please note that any costs exceeding this limit will be the participant's responsibility to cover.

been accepted on 11 June, 2025


- After we send you an email of invitation, you will be kindly requested to book your flight/train/bus tickets to Sofia and back home. Please note, the costs will be reimbursed to you in Bulgaria up to the Erasmus+ limits (please check them in the table on the next pages).
- Deadline to apply at 10 June, 2025 midnight Sofia time!

TRAVEL RULES



IMPORTANT: Participants must not purchase flights/Buses to Sofia until they receive official confirmation from the host organization. Once confirmed, each participant will have one week to:

- Find the most efficient and cost-effective travel option.
- Submit the travel plan to the host
 - organization for approval (tickets@ypeer.org)
- Proceed with the purchase only after receiving confirmation.
- After purchasing any online ticket, forward the email to (tickets@y-peer.org).
 Failure to do so may result in nonreimbursement of expenses.
- Tickets need participants name somewhere, prices, destinations, and dates. Please provide a clear scan of all paper tickets.



- Official language of the exchange is English.
- Travel expenses from your home country to Sofia, and back will be reimbursed once you are in Bulgaria, within the limit that the European Union calculated for participants from your country based on presented original tickets and

boarding passes.

- There will be Wi-Fi Internet available in the Venue.
- During your stay in Lozen, you will be given full board accommodation, breakfast, lunch, dinner, coffee breaks, and training facilities.
 Please keep in mind that you will be sharing a room with another person of the same gender up to (2-3 per room).
- A detailed agenda of the traning will be sent to you in the following weeks before the event.

TRAVEL COSTS REIMBURSEMENT



You can calculate the maximum amount of travel costs that we can reimburse based on the distance from your home to Sofia based on the Erasmus+ distance calculator. The distance ranges and the respective amounts are listed below:

Travel Distance

100 - 500 km	211 EUR
500 – 1999 km	309 EUR
2000 – 2999 km	395 EUR

The selected applicants from the following countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Greece, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, and Turkey are requested to travel sustainably by using land transportation, such as public buses or trains

Budget

REIMBURSEMENT RULES

- Reimbursement applies only to public transportation such as flights, trains, and buses. Travel by car, cabs or any other private means of transport is not eligible.
- Select a 10 kg hand luggage solution or Travel Backpack.
- You can arrive max two days before and leave max two days after the mobility. Arriving during the activities is not allowed.
- Erasmus+ program rules let us

reimburse your travel costs up to a certain amount which vary from country to country. We encourage you to choose the most direct and cost-effective option

Intercultural Evening
