

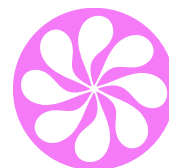

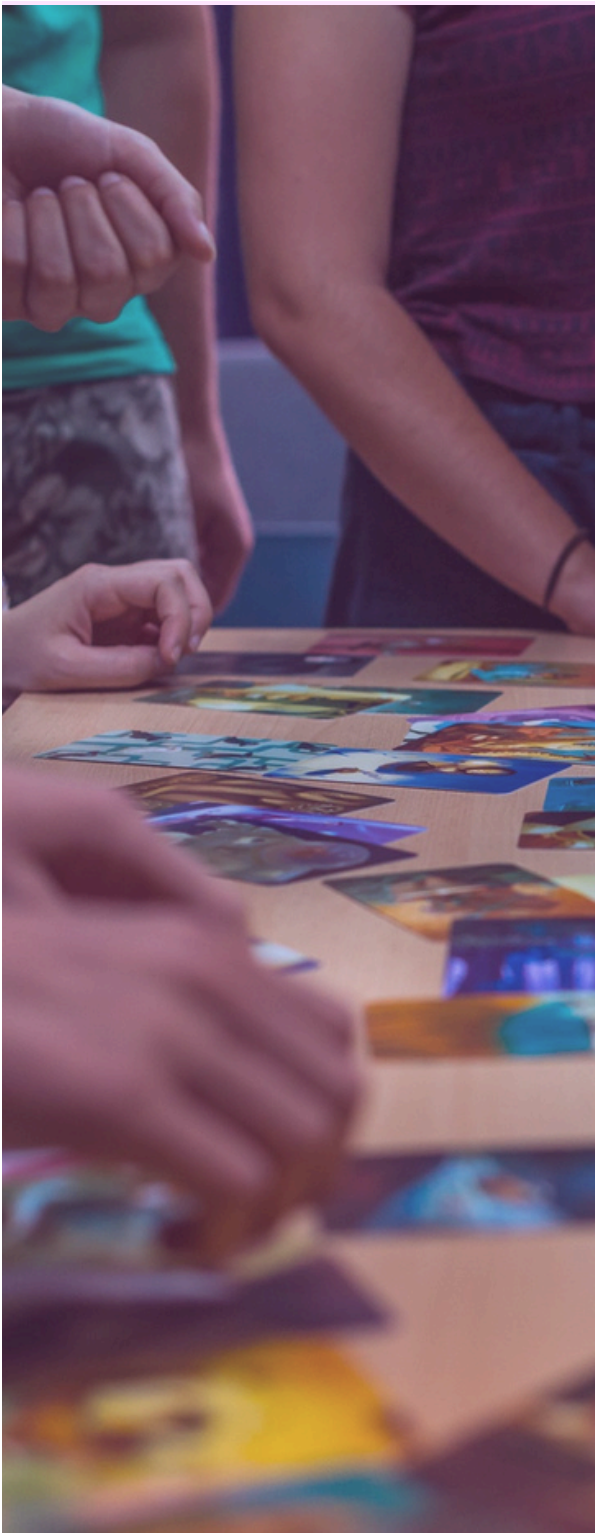
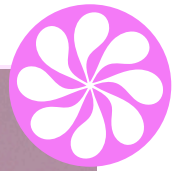

ABOUT THE PROGRAM



EntrepreNext is a Training Course that is based on entrepreneurial competences with a focus on competences that are crucial in the 21st century - including digital skills - while highlighting the importance of impact making. We will involve the topics of AI and how it affects the business scene and discuss controversies related to its use. We would like to create a space for youth workers, educators, mentors, young people who are thinking about setting up their own enterprises to learn about businesses, develop entrepreneurial competencies and practice how to create something new out of a simple idea.

Participants will get the chance to practice first hand the challenges of starting a business, work in a team, implement their ideas, using creativity, and a sense of initiative. Furthermore, they will explore how they can pass on this knowledge to their target groups, with what tools they can support young people to start their own journeys when developing a business idea.



METHODOLOGY

The main methods we use are gamification, simulations and creative recycling which is based on creativity, cooperation and crafting. We use creativity and upcycling as a tool to develop a range of skills.

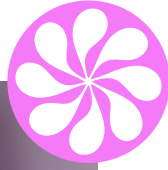
THE TEAM

LOGISTICS



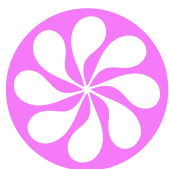
20-28 OCTOBER, 2025 | Hollókő, Hungary

There is NO Participation fee!

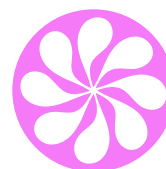
Conditions of reimbursement:

- resident permit if you are a not citizen in any of the partner countries



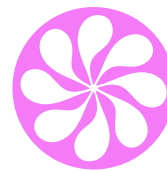
