

ABOUT THE PROJECT

PLAY IT FORWARD – MULTIPLAYER EVENT is an international training course and networking activity that explores **how educational games and playful methodologies can empower youth work**.

Through **hands-on methods**, collaborative activities, and **peer exchange**, participants will discover how **game-based learning** can be integrated into non-formal education to foster engagement, creativity, and critical thinking among young people.

Participants will learn how to:

- **Use and facilitate educational DIY games**—especially portable **escape boxes, card games, simulation** and **role-playing games**—in various youth work contexts (locally or internationally e.g. in youth exchanges)
- Understand the basic principles of designing educational games
- Apply game-based learning methods to strengthen young peoples competences on topics like **media and digital literacy, social inclusion, global citizenship** or **sustainability**
- Create **participatory** learning environments through playful approaches
- Build sustainable **partnerships** with youth workers and educators from different European countries (participants from Austria, Czech Republic, and Poland are expected)

A **highlight** of the exchange will be the visit to the **53rd International Mobile Play Congress** under the theme “Play Without Limits”, where participants will gain direct inspiration from practitioners and have the opportunity to practice facilitating educational games themselves.

VENUE




TRAVELS ARRANGEMENT

Selected and confirmed participants need to plan their trip to Chemnitz and back. Participants are requested to arrive in Chemnitz before 18:00 on October 22nd and to leave after breakfast on October 26th.

Participants are expected to travel during the arrival and departure days of the training. If an earlier or later travel day is necessary, additional expenses won't be covered by the hosting organization. The route of travel must be **cost-efficient** and direct from the home region of participants and back.

REIMBURSEMENT

Reimbursement of travel costs will be made by bank transfer after the training based on real costs, presented original tickets, boarding passes and invoices.

There is a fixed maximum amount reimbursable for the individual trip costs. Travel costs exceeding the maximum reimbursable amount will not be covered.


Travel budgets according to distance bands are:

- 10-99 Km | 28 EUR
- 100-499 Km | 211 EUR
- 500-1999 Km | 309 EUR

You can check the preliminary travel budget with the [Distance Calculator](#).

Reimbursements will be made by bank transfer to the organization or appointed responsible participant after the training and after all necessary travel documentation are sent to the hosting organization.

We ask you to choose a cost-efficient route and means of transport.



FURTHER PRACTICALITIES

Insurance: It is highly recommended to have a valid travel and medical insurance (i.e. European Health Insurance Card). The hosting organization will not cover any additional costs that might occur.

Fee: There is a participation fee of 40 EUR, that is used for the congress and for additional material that participants can take home. If for any reason you are not able to pay the fee, let us know.

Participation: We expect you to be fully present in the sessions, at least 80% of the content sessions. Inappropriate behavior might result in reimbursement not being given to the participants with a notice provided to the sending organization or exemption of the participant from the course.
