About ORIUNITE

ORIUNITE – Orienteering, Uniting Nations in Interactive Team Efforts is a European project funded by the Erasmus+ Sport programme. The project aims to use **orienteering as a tool for peacebuilding**, promoting dialogue, cooperation and reconciliation across communities historically divided by social, political, or ethnic conflicts.

The project focuses on symbolic border cities and regions across Europe – such as **Nicosia**, **Mostar**, **Gorizia/Nova Gorica**, **Dragonja/Savudrijska vala**, **Berlin**, and **Őrség** – where local and cross-border activities will be developed.

Objectives of the Training

The international training will gather selected participants from all partner organisations to:

- Develop a common understanding of the project's vision and objectives
- Deepen skills for planning and delivering inclusive orienteering events
- Explore tools for awareness workshops and cultural dialogue with youth
- Build capacity on stakeholder engagement and communication campaigns
- Design national/local action plans for implementation

- 1. <u>Orienteering/Technical Expert</u> to coordinate orienteering activities and map planning

- 3. <u>Communication/Engagement Lead</u> to lead community events, stakeholder involvement and support the national documentary production

- Committed to follow-up and lead local implementation
- Comfortable working in English (training language)
