About the project

Transformative Youth Leadership explores how young people can take part in shaping collective decisions and driving social change without reproducing the same hierarchical models they often face. It starts from the idea that leadership should not be about standing out, but about enabling others and building shared responsibility. The project looks at how youth work can help develop this kind of leadership through reflection, dialogue, and cooperation, especially in contexts marked by inequality and disconnection. It brings together organizations that want to turn leadership into a practice of empowerment and participation, not control.

This learning, teaching, training (LTT) serves as the creative and methodological core of the project. During the training, **partners and participants will co-develop, test, and refine the tools and approaches that form the project's educational methodology.** The focus will be on translating the project's concepts into practical methods that can later be applied in local and international youth work contexts. Through experimentation, reflection, and feedback, the LTT will lay the groundwork for the pilot phase that follows.



Participants and travel budget

Accommodation, food and activities' materials: 100% covered by the Erasmus+ Programme.

Travel costs: The travel from your hometown to Teulada and back is covered by the project budget up to a limit. This limit is set by the Erasmus+ Programme rules and calculated using the Erasmus+ Distance Calculator tool. Maximum travel budgets are:

Language used

The activities of the project will have English as the main communication language. It is therefore a participation requisite to have an English level good enough to be able to follow the activities and actively engage in them.

How to reach the venue?

Participants will be taken by bus to the venue from Alicante. Therefore, please, **make sure to be in the city of Alicante on November 29th at 19:00.**

As a major city, and a popular touristic destination, Alicante is well-connected to most airports in Europe. Thus, the best way to go to Alicante is usually to find a direct flight to the city.

In case you can't find a suitable flight to Alicante, we recommend flying to either Valencia or Madrid. Both cities also enjoy great connections with other countries and are well-connected with Alicante by train, bus, and roads.

Remember! Activities begin on **November 30th at 9:00** and finish on **December 5th at 19:00**. You have to be in Teulada between those two dates. Accommodation and meals will be provided in the Casa Miquel November 29th evening till December 6th morning.

The mobility will take place in Casa Miquel, Teulada, Alicante ([Camí de Sant Miquel, 6, 03725 Teulada, Alicante](#)). Participants will stay in non-mixed rooms of 2-4 people.



WEATHER

Temperatures in late November are usually mild, with around 20°C during the day and around 10° at night. Though not part of the rainy season, occasional rains are not uncommon.
