Training course on Legislative Theatre methodology

6th-15th of February (Busteni, Romania)







Background of this training course:

Theatre of the Oppressed is a collective rehearsal for reality. Theatre of the Oppressed methods are highly adaptable to the needs of different communities, with a large capacity cover all kinds of social issues: human rights problems, power abuse and oppression in different ways, lack of activism, discrimination, exclusion, poverty, marginalization, xenophobia, etc. and through a creative approach provides a space for people to reflect, find solutions to these topics and transfer the solutions in their lives.

Through Legislative Theatre, we address systemic issues, and call for systemic change through consultations with the affected target groups - this methodology allows you to work with vulnerable groups, to work grassroot, and to have a direct interaction and impact in the lives of oppressed young people.

The aim of our training is to increase youth workers capacities in using Legislative Theatre methodology in addressing systemic change and empower youth workers to work with public authorities in advocacy processes.

There is no need for prior experience in theatre methods or Theatre of the Oppressed methodologies.



Available to travel to Romania and take part in the training program (they need to have a valid passport by the time of the application).

Other aspects

Important to have in mind before deciding to apply:

- If you do not provide an OID number your application will be considered ineligible.
- Your organization should be based in the same country as you are currently residing in. If your situation is different you might not be eligible to participate in the course.
- The process of the training prioritizes a quality and intensive learning process. There will be 6 hours of learning sessions every day and 1 half a day free from sessions in the entire training. There will be no trips or organized excursions offered – each participant will organize their free time as they wish.

Facilitators

The learning process will be guided and facilitated by Antonia Pîslariu and Monica Tudorache who share strong passion for promoting diversity, tolerance and a deep exploration of various human rights issues.

They bring to life powerful projects which embed a human rights culture and address various important issues through Theatre of the Oppressed methodology.



Costs



Board and lodging for the training course which takes place in Romania are fully covered by the local organizers during the period mentioned.



International and local travel costs for the training course which takes place in Romania will be reimbursed to you 30 days after the training in the cost bands covered by Erasmus+.



Visa-related costs are covered 100 % by A.R.T. Fusion.



More about expenses:

- Each participant is free to choose the preferred way of travelling. Due to the organizers' policies, we strongly encourage the use of green travel, especially from the neighbouring countries to Romania. If flights are used for more than 50% of the total travel distance (roundway) the maximum budget allocated available will be from the Non-Green travel category.

The individual maximum budget for travel, per person, is the following:

100 - 499 km 285 EUR (Green Travel) / 211 EUR (Non-Green Travel)

500 – 1999 km 417 EUR (Green Travel) / 309 EUR (Non-Green Travel)

2000 – 2999 km 535 EUR (Green Travel) / 395 EUR (Non-Green Travel)

3000 – 3999 km 785 EUR (Green Travel)/ 580 EUR (Non-Green Travel)
