

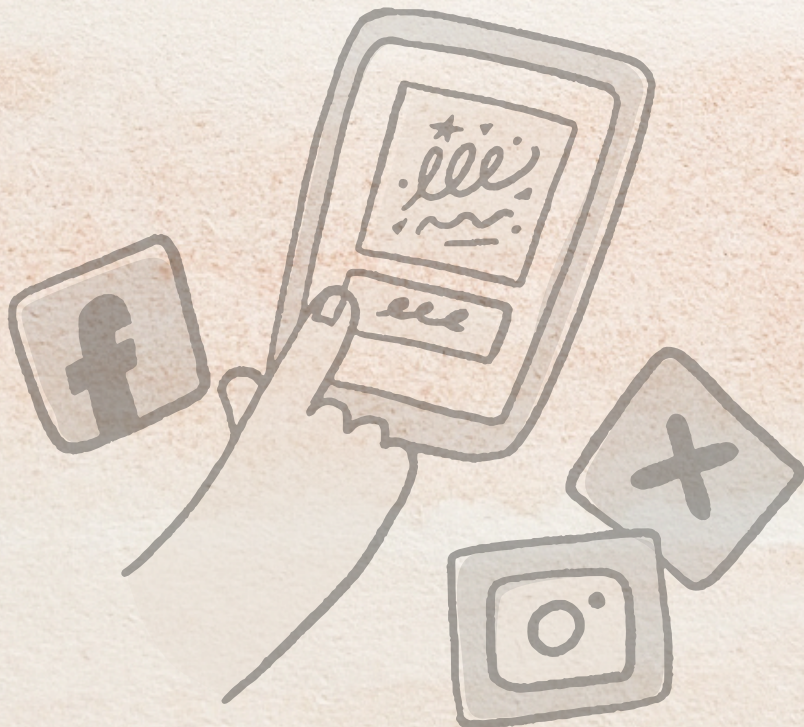

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Encourage youth workers to use language as a tool for identity and cultural connection.
- Strengthen critical thinking, creativity, and digital literacy in youth work.
- Support inclusion, intercultural understanding, and sustainable communication habits.
- Create practical educational resources for youth work on language and culture.

Activities

- Non-formal workshops, creative media labs, and cultural evenings.
- Fieldwork on language and communication habits among youth.

All activities follow Erasmus+ values of inclusion, participation, and sustainability.

- Participants coming from Türkiye (7), Belgium (7), Bulgaria (7), Hungary (7), Ukraine (7) and Jordan (7).

- Individuals who have no travel restrictions and can participate in all project days (16–22 December 2025, Ankara).
- People who can communicate in English, which will be the working language of the project

Ankara is the capital and second largest city of Türkiye. Located in the Central Anatolia Region, the city has an altitude of over 1,000 meters. With a population of 5.6 million, Ankara is an important center both historically and politically.



ACCOMODATION

The project will take place in Çankaya, one of the central districts of Ankara.

The project area is located in a very convenient location in terms of transportation. It is 31 km (approximately 35 minutes) away from Ankara Esenboğa Airport. It is also 5.7 km (approximately 10 minutes) away from the train station and 5.3 km from the bus station. There are various public transportation options such as metro, bus, tram and taxi.

Travel, three meals per day and accommodation will be covered entirely by the organization.



ACCOMODATION

Three meals and coffee breaks will be provided daily, accustomed to the needs of the participants (I.e.,vegan, vegetarian, halal...).

Wireless internet connection is available in the hotel

You Will be accommodated in rooms of 2 or 3 people.

ÇANKAYA

You can take a direct bus from the airport to Çankaya (bus number 442). The price for a ticket is 75₺ = 1,98€

You can also reach the city center from the airport with a shuttle called HAVAŞ or BELKO, the service price is 180₺ = 3,75€



Reimbursement Terms:

- 1- The travel invoice, boarding pass, the Türkiye entry stamp page in your passport, the entry document for those entering with an ID card, and travel health insurance must be submitted to the coordinator.
- 2- All invoices for visa expenses must be submitted to the coordinator. Invoices must have an English translation.
- 3- Full participation in project activities is required.
- 4- Public transportation must be preferred for local travel.
- 5- Information must be provided to the coordinator regarding cultural promotion expenses.

Belgium: up to €395 per participant
Jordan: up to €309 per participant
Ukraine: up to €309 per participant
Hungary: up to €309 per participant
Türkiye: €28 per participant (local participants)



Reimbursement Terms:

To be eligible for travel reimbursement, all participants must carefully follow the rules below and complete the Google Form in full.

Conditions for Reimbursement

- Use the cheapest travel option available (economy class; book early when possible).
- Choose sustainable/green transport whenever possible (bus, train, tram, metro). Taxi costs will not be reimbursed.
- Keep all original travel documents (boarding passes, tickets, invoices, receipts with stamps where applicable).
- Upload scanned copies or clear photos of all travel documents to the Google Form no later than the second day of the project.
- Travel dates must correspond to the official project dates (15–22 December 2025).
 - Extra days (more than one week before/after) or personal trips will not be reimbursed unless approved in advance by the coordinator.
- Incomplete submissions, missing documents, or failure to follow these rules will result in no reimbursement.

Only participants who fully complete the form and provide all required documents will be eligible for reimbursement.
