PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project was born from the growing need to address environmental problems such as waste accumulation, overconsumption, and carbon emissions. Youth workers play a vital role in shaping the environmental awareness of the next generation.

Main aim:

To equip youth workers with the necessary knowledge, skills, and motivation to promote environmental sustainability in their local communities.

Specific objectives:

- Raise awareness about environmental challenges and sustainable lifestyles.
- Provide knowledge on waste management, recycling, renewable energy, carbon footprint, and water safety.
- Encourage eco-friendly practices and responsible consumption.
- Foster European cooperation in youth work for a greener future.

Expected impact:

Participants will gain competences to educate young people on sustainability and create eco-friendly projects within their organisations and local areas.

ACTIVITY DETAILS

- Location: Sakarya, Türkiye
- Dates: 8-15 February 2026
- Duration: 8 days (6 training days)
- Language: English
- Participants: 33 youth workers (4 per country, including 1 with fewer opportunities)
- Trainer: 1 experienced trainer from Türkiye

Main topics covered:

- Waste management & recycling
- Alternative and renewable energy sources
- Fossil fuel impact on the environment
- Carbon footprint calculation
- Water safety and environmental health
- Sustainable living practices

Training methods:

Non-formal education, group workshops, brainstorming, outdoor learning, experiential learning, and daily reflection sessions.

By the end of the project, participants will:

- Have a stronger awareness of environmental and sustainability issues.
- Know how to design and deliver eco-focused activities for young people.
- Be able to measure and reduce their personal and institutional carbon footprint.
- ✓ Gain new partnerships and good practices from across Europe.
- Be inspired to take action for a greener planet.

- Youth workers, trainers, NGO staff, or volunteers who have been active in youth work for over 3 years.
- Participants who are motivated to apply what they learn with young people.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Workshops and Training Sessions:

-Interactive workshops on waste management, recycling, renewable energy, carbon footprint calculation, and sustainable living, using nonformal learning methods and digital tools for daily reflection.

Field Visits:

-Practical observations through local waste audits and recycling centre visits, allowing participants to experience sustainability in action.

Peer Learning and Cultural Exchange:

-Collaborative and creative group activities, including intercultural evenings and photo storytelling, to encourage teamwork and cultural understanding.

Expert Talks and Discussions:

-Sessions with local experts and NGOs on environmental challenges and innovative green practices.

Community Engagement Events:

-Social media campaigns and awareness activities on global warming, waste reduction, and eco-friendly habits.

Evaluation and Dissemination:

-Daily reflections, final evaluation, and certificate ceremony, followed by local workshops and online sharing of results.

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

Health Insurance Certificate: A valid health insurance policy for the duration of the project.

HEALTH INSURANCE IS NOT PROVIDED AND THE PROJECT GRANT WILL NOT BE REFUNDABLE, ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST PURCHASE PRIVATE TRAVEL INSURANCE.

Health insurance must meet the following criteria:

- Comprehensive Coverage: The insurance must provide comprehensive coverage for medical emergencies, accidents and illnesses that may occur during the program.
- Repatriation Coverage: The insurance must provide repatriation coverage in the event that the participant needs to be repatriated to their home country for medical attention.
- Emergency assistance
- Pre-existing conditions

Participants with specific dietary requirements, intolerances, allergies or other eating habits must notify the host organization at least one week prior to arrival so that options can be discussed with the hotel and meals can be rearranged. Information received after this date cannot be taken into account regarding participants' meals and menus. It is important to state your dietary habits, allergies, intolerances and medical conditions in the application form. Participants should recommend any necessary medications they use or think they need to use daily during the project.

What to bring:

Comfortable Clothing: Suitable clothing for walking and outdoor activities.

Personal Hygiene Products: Please bring personal care products, slippers and towels that you may need during your stay at the hotel.

Digital Devices: Laptop, tablet or mobile phone for presentations and events.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND RULES



• Participants should participate in the activities on time and actively. The photos and videos taken during the project will be used for Erasmus+dissemination activities. If you have any objections about this, please contact the organizers.

• Those who violate the established rules of the project, harass others, undermine the prestige of the organization, or commit systematic violations of the established norms will be excluded from the project. The sending organisation will be informed of this by email with details of the case and the specific reasons for removal.

- sharing the tools, methods, or ideas developed during the course.

Participants and partner organizations are encouraged to tag project partners and use Erasmus+ visibility guidelines when sharing online content.

The main aim is to multiply the project's impact and spread awareness about youth work for environmental sustainability.

Reimbursement


Travel costs will be reimbursed according to Erasmus+ distance band limits and upon submission of all original travel documents (boarding passes, tickets, invoices, etc.).

Participants are kindly asked to:

- keep all travel documents (both digital and printed),
- send them to the organizer immediately after the mobility,
- ensure that travel routes comply with Erasmus+ rules.

Reimbursements will be processed via bank transfer to your organization after the organizer receives and verifies all necessary documents and reports.

Please note that the reimbursement process may take up to two months after the end of the training course.
