WHAT IS IKIGAI?



From IKIGAI to Action: Youth Employability & Social Impact is a six-day training course, taking place from March 17 to March 22, designed to support youth workers and young people aspiring to become youth workers in exploring purpose, employability and social impact through the IKIGAI framework.

The project aims to transform IKIGAI from a personal reflection tool into a practical methodology for youth work, supporting young people in connecting their passions, skills and values with meaningful social action.

OBJECTIVES

-  To support youth workers and young people interested in youth work in strengthening their personal and professional purpose through the IKIGAI framework.
-  To provide practical tools and methodologies for youth orientation and employability, integrating IKIGAI into non-formal education and youth work practices.
-  To encourage the transformation of personal purpose into concrete social action, fostering active participation and local initiatives in participants' communities.

HOW?

The Training Course will be implemented through **non-formal education methods**, combining **experiential learning, self-reflection and peer learning**. Participants will explore and apply the IKIGAI framework through interactive workshops and group activities, transforming personal insights into practical tools for youth work. The process will support participants in developing concrete ideas and follow-up actions to be implemented in their local contexts.

WHO?

The training course is designed for **30 participants** who are expected to be active and have at least some experience in working with young people, such as **facilitators, youth workers, trainers, educators, mentors, youth leaders, community leaders, etc.** Participants need to have a good command of the English language and be motivated to fully commit to the training course and to the local follow-up activities afterwards.

WHO WE ARE?

COSTS & TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

The maximum **TRAVEL COST** reimbursement is based on the distance calculator supported by the European Union. We will **NOT reimburse** the amounts that get over the maximum budget for each participant, or the tickets that did not receive previous **APPROVAL**


According to the restrictions of the E+ Programme, we can only refund if:

Your travel route is **from your hometown to the venue** in Italy and back (check for exceptional cases with the coordinator)

You have chosen **reasonable and economic means** of transportation (e.g. Economy fares for flight tickets, cheap airlines, 2nd class trains)

Your **travel dates** are according to the programme (1 day before OR after the project dates is allowed, but lodging during these days is on your own expenses)

You have a **receipt or invoice** for the cost of your plane ticket and the **boarding pass** or the **train/bus tickets**



In case of **green travel**, participants have 2 travel days for arrival and other 2 travel days for return

HOW TO REACH US

The closest airport is **Lamezia Terme**, it doesn't have many international flights, but it is well connected with many Italian international airports, like Milan, Rome, Pisa, Naples. From Lamezia or other airports, you can take a train to **Castiglione Cosentino train station** or a **Bus to Rende**, which will be the final destination of your trip. Once in Rende, you can use apps like Cosenza Autolinee TPL to buy urban bus tickets.
