His work focuses on inclusive learning environments, non-formal education, and creative processes with diverse groups, including young people and community practitioners. Through his artistic and educational practice, Juan David explores how music can foster dialogue, reflection, and social connection, supporting individuals and groups in developing their own voices through collaborative creation.

JOCHEN SCHELL

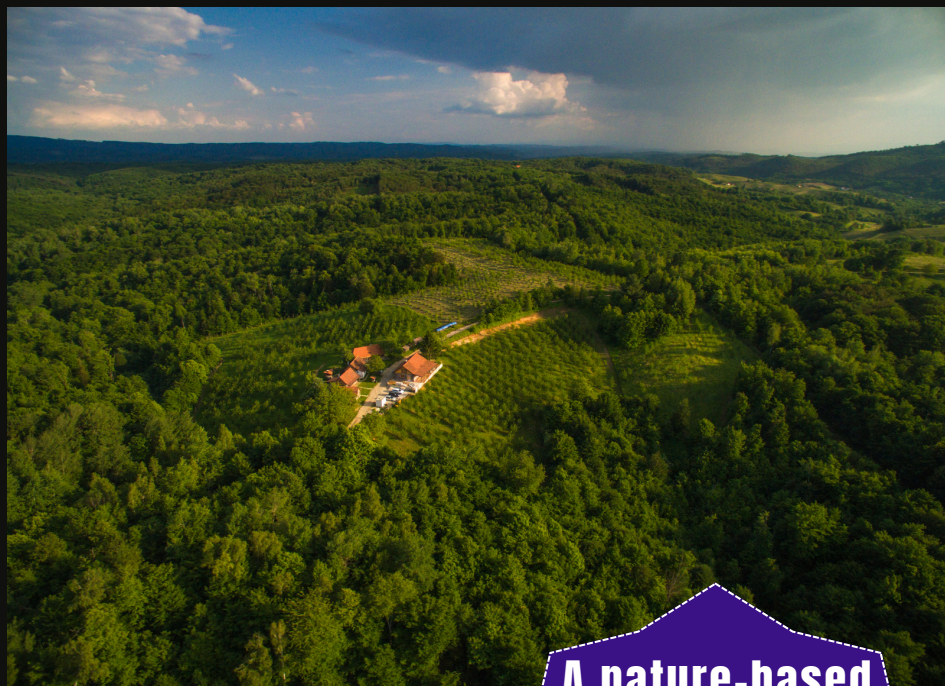
SONGS FOR RIGHTS FOUNDER & DIRECTOR
