





Arenas de San Pedro is a picturesque town in the province of Ávila, Spain, nestled in the Sierra de Gredos and known for its rich history, natural beauty, and cultural heritage. The region is known as the Tiétar Valley with its 6300 inhabitants, as an administrative centre of the valley.

Working place

- **Primary Arrival Airport:** The preferred option is to fly directly to Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport (Madrid) for the most convenient access to Arenas de San Pedro.
- **Alternative Options:** If direct flights to Madrid are not available, you can fly to Barcelona or Valencia. From there, you can take a train to Madrid. Spain's high-speed train network offers comfortable and efficient connections between these cities.

From Madrid Airport to the Bus Station (Estación Sur Méndez Álvaro):


- Take Metro Line 8 from Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport to Nuevos Ministerios.
- Transfer to Metro Line 6 and travel to Méndez Álvaro station.
- Exit at Méndez Álvaro for the Madrid-Estación Sur de Autobuses.

From the bus station to Arenas de San Pedro:


- Take the bus operated by Samar to Arenas de San Pedro.
- Ticket Price: €12.93 (Tickets can be purchased online at samar.es).
- **Important:** Please check the bus schedule in advance, as buses are not frequent throughout the day.

Travel Budget

Refund

Before the training, you will need to purchase your tickets to travel to Arenas de San Pedro, Spain. During the training, we will collect all your travel receipts and tickets as proof of purchase. We will then sign a reimbursement contract to confirm the agreed amount. The reimbursement will be processed and transferred to your account within approximately 2 months after the training.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- **Pre-Approved Tickets:** Only tickets that have been approved before the training by the hosting organization will be eligible for reimbursement.
- **Keep Your Receipts:** Make sure to keep all your receipts and tickets as they are required for reimbursement.
- **Full Participation:** To qualify for reimbursement, you must participate in all the sessions of the training.
