# Introduction

**Are you a youth worker from Slovenia or Serbia looking to gain practical hand-on skills and confidence in moderating, facilitating, and organizing public events? Do you want to ensure inclusivity, engagement and professional execution in youth activities? Then this training is for you!**

This five-day intensive training course is designed to equip 20 youth workers from Serbia and Slovenia with the skills and confidence to plan, facilitate, and moderate public events in the field of youth.

These events include debates, forums, public dialogues, workshops, panel discussions, networking activities, and community initiatives.




You will learn **how to structure events step-by-step**, engage diverse audiences, and make your activities inclusive and accessible for all, including marginalized groups.



You will also become **part of a network of trained youth facilitators**, enhancing your ability to mentor young leaders, strengthen youth engagement, and apply your skills in your local communities.



Through non-formal education, experiential learning, and real-world simulations, you will **gain hands-on experience in public speaking, facilitation techniques, as well as ethical moderation.**



# Training Objectives and Content

Participants of the training course will:

01)

**Strengthen facilitation and public speaking skills:** gain confidence, practice verbal/non-verbal techniques, and grasp moderation in real-world event simulations.

02)

**Ensure inclusivity and diversity:** learn methods to engage marginalized youth, adapt facilitation to different audiences, and design accessible events.

03)

**Acquire practical tools for organising youth public events:** use structured planning tools, checklists, as well as exercises to confidently organize youth initiatives.

04)


**Build networks and foster collaboration:** connect with other youth workers from Serbia and Slovenia and establish ongoing peer support.

05)


**Benefit from long-term mentorship:** develop personalized action plans and receive guidance from trainers to apply new skills in local communities.


