CARRIÓN DE LOS CONDES (SPAIN)

ABOUT THIS *Training course*

This international training course is specifically designed for *youth professionals* working in **rural** settings who support vulnerable young people from diverse **cultural, ethnic, and/or religious** backgrounds, often facing limited opportunities due to their **migrant** status or other external barriers.

The main objective is to **co-create** a joint working **methodology** and share proven tools and best practices to overcome **external obstacles** (discrimination, prejudice, emotional displacement, and linguistic barriers) that restrict the opportunities available to these young people.



DURING THIS TRAINING COURSE, YOU WILL:

- Establish durable **international cooperation** among the five partner organizations to exchange **successful practices** and build a more **inclusive** and diverse world.
- Directly **empower young people** with fewer opportunities who will benefit from the positive outcomes and improved methodologies resulting from this training.
- Design and develop **innovative** and **creative tools** that will be piloted by each partner organization within their entities and then disseminated to other relevant organizations in their respective countries.
- Foster **active** and **inclusive** participation by leveraging digital platforms, specifically through podcasting, to create a shared, accessible space for dialogue and visibility.
- **Raise awareness** and promote common European values regarding inclusion, diversity, environment, climate change, and equality among youth professionals.





DISSEMINATION AFTER THE MOBILITY

- Social media and podcasting campaign to raise awareness about the topics discussed here.
- Local follow-up actions through practical workshops or dedicated training sessions back to their countries.
- Together we will co-create a **HANDBOOK OF GOOD PRACTICES** to share with other entities and implement in our own organizations.



Participants profile

- Be over 18 years old
- Be working with young people on regular basis (youth workers, teachers, social workers, educators, youth leaders, trainers...)
- Be interested in the topic, and non-formal education as experiential learning.
- Be part of the participating organizations, or from allied organizations that work with disadvantaged youth
- Be a resident of **Bulgaria, France, Greece, Lithuania or Spain**

Each sending organization with the **approval of the host organization** will choose the best participants for this project.

We will **contact you** for the next steps and we will have a **videocall** before the project dates for previous arrangements.

IT IS REQUIRED TO SPEAK AT LEAST INTERMEDIATE LEVEL OF ENGLISH



Venue

Accommodation will be provided at **Hostal Santiago**, located in the center of the town. Participants will be lodged in private rooms for 2-3 people, each with its own private bathroom.

All meals (including **breakfast, lunch, and dinner**, along with **two daily coffee breaks**) will be served at the **CDR** (Centro de Desarrollo Rural), which is also the location where all project activities will take place.

MADRID AIRPORT



Search for a **flight** from your country to Adolfo Suárez - Barajas **Airport** (Madrid)

PALENCIA STATION



Take the metro to **Chamartín station** and catch a **train** to Palencia.

CARRIÓN DE LOS CONDES



There, take a **bus** to Carrión (we will share the timetables with you once you have been selected).





Participants are able to travel 1-2 days **before**, OR 1-2 days **after** the project dates. But accomodation will not be covered on those days.

Reimbursement

Travel reimbursement will be made withing 3 months after the project ending by bank transfer. Beforehand, you must complete the participant report and local dissemination.

**All tickets and boarding
passes must be kept in
original and/or PDF format.**

Do NOT purchase tickets until you have confirmation from the sending organization.

*Whenever green travel is eligible, it is required. This budget is with green travel: low-emissions means of transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling.

Practical aspects



It is mandatory to have a valid travel and medical insurance (i.e **European Health Insurance Card**) during your travel.



We recommend you to bring any **personal items** you may need as toiletries (towels are provided in the hostel) and there are many shops in the town. All basic services are covered.



Failure to participate in at least **80% of the sessions** and program content, or inappropriate behavior, will be grounds for being asked to leave the project and for travel expenses not being reimbursed.



THERE IS NO PARTICIPATION FEE TO TAKE PART IN THIS TRAINING COURSE.


