The Project

This project “Strengthening Facilitation Skills of Youth Workers” aims to improve the facilitation skills of youth workers, especially those from rural areas with limited access to professional development opportunities. By strengthening their capacity to lead non-formal learning activities, manage group dynamics and use digital tools in youth work, the project will contribute to more engaging, inclusive and sustainable youth work practices across Europe.

The Objectives of the project are:

1. Develop facilitation competencies by equipping youth workers with interactive, learner-centered methodologies that they can apply in their organizations and Erasmus+ projects.
2. Improve the quality and effectiveness of non-formal education by training youth workers in inclusive facilitation techniques, group management strategies and digital learning tools.
3. Provide youth workers with skills to create inclusive and accessible learning environments, enabling them to support and engage disadvantaged youth, especially from rural areas.
4. Integrate sustainability and digitalization into youth work by providing environmentally friendly educational practices and digital facilitation tools that can increase youth participation.
5. Promote international cooperation and networking among youth workers and organizations, creating long-term partnerships for future Erasmus+ projects and knowledge exchange.

About Évora

Évora is a city and a municipality in Portugal.

Dating prior to the Roman conquest, Évora's History is marked by the passage and formation of Empires and by its multicultural History marked by the several cultures and religions throughout the millennia, with a big influence from the Catholic Christianity, Islam and Judaism. Many of its monuments are well preserved, said monuments range from Roman buildings to Renaissance architecture to XX century historical buildings. Some of the most well-known are the Roman Temple, the See Cathedral, the Bones Chapel and the Palace of D. Manuel. Évora is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1986.

The population is around 53.500 inhabitants.

Climate

In April, the temperatures will be between 20°C and 25°C by day and between 8°C and 10°C by night, for which we recommend for you to bring both warm and cooler clothes. We also recommend to bring a jacket, because the nights are still cold. We also provide you with the IPMA website in English where you can find an accurate weather report.

Three (3) or four (4) days before departure, you can always check the weather via online, following the link and select the **District** "Évora" and the **City** "Évora":

Travel Rules


You must choose the optimal tickets for your travel.

- **Do not buy your tickets without confirmation from your project coordinator;**
- **Do not use a taxi or a private car.** It may not be an eligible cost if there are other options available;
- **Never lose your boarding cards, e-tickets, invoices and bus/train tickets.** You will need to keep them and send them to us, for we make the reimbursement to you and your team.

Travel Information

Bus and Train

When arriving in Portugal, there is now an option of taking a bus directly from *Lisboa Humberto Delgado Airport* to *Évora*, which are *FlixBus*. Just install a APP and buy the tickets online.

Other options could be the *Rede Expressos* Bus Station (<https://rede-expressos.pt/en>) finding the station called “Lisboa(Sete Rios)” or “Lisboa(Oriente)”, or by *Train* (<https://www.cp.pt/passageiros/en>) finding the train station called “Lisboa Oriente”, “Lisboa Sete Rios” or “Entrecampos”.

Metro

The new metro red line stations.

- If you come by train to Évora you should go out in the 3rd station called “Oriente”;

- If you come to Évora by bus you should go to “S. Sebastião” station (blue line), change train and go out at bus station “Jardim Zoológico”.

The ticket prices are 1,80€ in the occasional trips option.

Taxi/Uber (If you choose this option, you may not be reimbursed)

Travelling by taxi (**will not be reimbursed**) from the airport is also an option. It will cost you between 10€ and 20€ with luggage.

Uber is also a viable option. Uber prices: between 5€ and 10€ to “Entrecampos”; “Sete Rios” between 6€ and 12€; “Oriente” between 5€ and 8€ (may be reimbursed if its within the budget limit and you must kept the receipt).

How to get to Évora and back to Lisbon

By Rede Expresso bus

The **maximum** you can pay for a **bus ticket is 12,50€** and **minimum is 3,95€**. Here is the link where you can plan out your travels: <https://rede-expressos.pt/en>

To come– Daily schedule from “Sete Rios” and “Oriente” bus station to Évora, will cost about 3,95€ (depending on the plane arriving schedules can be more expensive).

Return trip- Daily schedule from “Sete Rios” and “Oriente” bus station to Évora, will cost about 3,95€ (depending on the plane arriving schedules can be more expensive).

***Note:** the last bus to leave Lisbon is from “Sete Rios” Station at 22h30 p.m.

By FlixBus

To come...

...from Lisboa Airport - The maximum you can pay for a bus ticket is 10,48€ (depending on the plane arriving, schedules can be more expensive).

...from Lisboa Oriente - The maximum you can pay for a bus ticket is 4,48€ and minimum is 3,98€ (depending on the plane arriving, schedules can be more expensive).

Return trip...

...to Lisboa Airport - The maximum you can pay for a bus ticket is 8,49€ (depending on the plane arriving, schedules can be more expensive).

...to Lisboa Oriente - The maximum you can pay for a bus ticket is 10,49€ and minimum is 2,99€ (depending on the plane arriving, schedules can be more expensive).

By train

Accommodation

All participants will stay at the “**Seminário Maior de Évora**”.

The “**Seminário Maior de Évora**” is just a 12-minute walk from the Chapel of Bones. Praça do Giraldo is about a 10-minute walk away. Religious sites in the area include the Roman Temple of Évora (5 minute walk). The accommodation will be divided in double rooms.

How to get to Seminário Maior de Évora

After you arrive to Évora by bus or train, you have 3 options to reach Seminário Maior de Évora:

- Urban Bus “Trevo” (1,55€ each ticket)
- Taxi/Uber - **will not be reimbursed**;
- Foot (20-30 minutes walking);




Figura 1 From Bus Station to Seminário on foot.




Figure 2. From Train Station to Seminário on foot.
