- Ability to build team spirit and trust
- Ability to match team member competences to the objectives of the activity
- Managing disagreements constructively
- Encouraging and involving other team members
- Learning with and from team members.

**"Collaborating in teams" means that the youth worker contributes to team work and maintains good working relations with everyone involved with the project. The youth worker motivates and supports colleagues in achieving given objectives. This competence area also includes systemic cooperation and responsibility in an international context.
