If you are not selected, you can purchase the course for the full price according the price list of the organizer, we will still assist you with travel and accommodation.

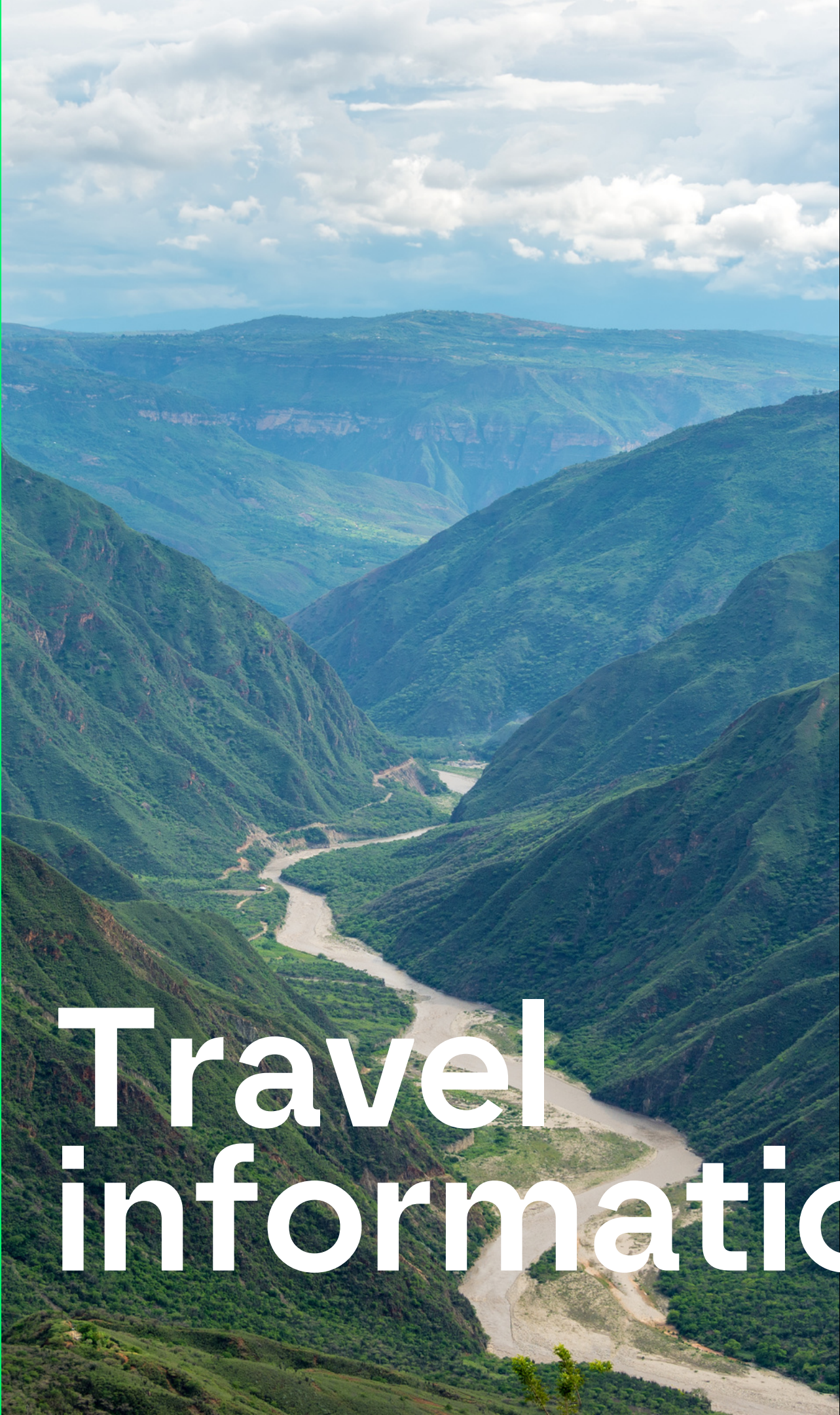
