OBJECTIVES

- Equip youth workers with digital tools and non-formal methods to promote young people's democratic participation.
- Strengthen competences in facilitating civic engagement, active citizenship, and inclusive participation through digital technologies.
- Enhance understanding of digital citizenship, media literacy, and responsible online participation.
- Develop skills to create safe, inclusive, and engaging digital learning environments for young people.
- Explore innovative digital tools and participatory methods that can be integrated into everyday youth work.
- Encourage the exchange of good practices, international cooperation, and the development of future Erasmus+ initiatives.

PARTICIPANTS' PROFILE

We are looking for youth workers to join the training who:

- Are aged 18+
- Are residents in one of the Erasmus+ programme countries - all EU member states, North Macedonia, Serbia, Türkiye, as well as in associated countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine.
- Have the experience in working/volunteering with organizations on programs/projects for youth
- Are available for the whole period of the training course
- Are open to learning, developing new skills, acquiring knowledge related to non-formal educational methods and working with disadvantaged groups
- Are able to engage a group in an educational process, appreciate an interactive model of learning, create a comfortable environment, convey accurate information, mediate conflicts and understand group dynamics.

- Please note that it is mandatory to fill in the application form, in order to take part in the training. Only the selected participants will be notified by email that their application has been accepted by 1 October 2026.
- After we send you an email invitation, you will be kindly requested to book your flight/train/bus tickets to Sofia and back home (after our approval). Please note, the costs will be reimbursed to you by bank transfer after the project up to the Erasmus+ limits (please check them in the table on the next pages).
- Please note that 20 October 2026 is the arrival day in the Canary Islands and 26 October is the departure day. You can stay up to 2 additional days in Spain on your own expenses.
- **The deadline to apply is 25 August 2026.**



PRACTICAL INFORMATION



- The official language of the training course is English.
- Travel expenses from your home country to the Canary Islands and back will be reimbursed within the limit that Erasmus+ programme foresees for participants from your country based on presented original tickets and boarding passes.
- The accommodation for the training duration will be in Fuerteventura or Gran Canaria (we are going to give more details to selected participants as soon as possible).
- During your stay, you will be provided with full board accommodation (breakfast, lunch, dinner). Please keep in mind that you will be sharing a room with other participants from the same gender.



TRAVEL COSTS REIMBURSEMENT

Travel expenses will be reimbursed after the completion of the project to the bank account provided by each participant, upon receipt of all required supporting documents, including invoices, tickets, and boarding passes.

The maximum reimbursement for a round trip is **EUR 300 per participant**. Any travel expenses exceeding this amount will be borne by the participant.





KEY MOMENTS

During the training course there will be an intercultural evening. You will get the chance to present your country.

We will set up tables for your country and we would like to invite you to bring any promotional materials, products, videos, clothes, foods and drinks, in order to present your country and share what is special and unique about it with the rest of the participants. Videos, quiz games, songs and dances or any other creative expressions are encouraged!
