Aims of the Project:

- To give youth workers knowledge about digital violence: cyberbullying, harassment, digital partner violence, AI-based risks and violence in VR spaces.
- To create practical non-formal tools, such as VR activities, digital storytelling and community workshops.
- To develop resources like a toolkit, awareness videos and recommendations for NGOs, schools and policymakers.
- To build a strong cooperation between Türkiye and European organisations, creating a network that continues after the project.



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Training Aim:

To equip youth workers with practical knowledge and skills to recognise, prevent, and respond to digital violence, including cyberbullying, online harassment, hate speech, and emerging digital risks, through non-formal education methods.

Participant Profile:

- Active youth workers, professionals or volunteers, working directly with young people.
- **Age 22-45**
- Working in NGOs, youth centres, schools, municipalities, or community organisations.
- Interested in digital violence, cyberbullying, online safety, and violence prevention.
- Motivated to apply and share the knowledge gained in their local communities.
- Open to non-formal learning, intercultural teamwork, and active participation.
- Priority will also be given to gender balance and the inclusion of youth workers with fewer opportunities
- The level of English should be C1
