WHY TO ENGAGE IN THIS COURSE?

The **"Training course on Children Rights promoting Emancipation"** is an opportunity for educators and youth leaders working with children, teenagers and youth to develop methodological competences in the implementation of activities dealing with Human Rights Education with children, as a step towards an effective promotion of their participation in society.

The course will be focused on how the development of activities on Children Rights and Participation can become a powerful pedagogical tool to strengthen children's autonomy and to promote their emancipation in society, important goals to combat Social Exclusion.

Moreover, the event will contribute to establish a lasting partnership with other organisations that work with young people and children around Europe, providing space for project planning among the organisations involved in the course.

Above all, this Training Course is just for YOU, to self-develop new competences as educator, to better address new interests for your *esplai*, *circolo*, *centre*, etc., and to promote education for diversity within your organisation through creating spaces where Children can share experiences with peers from other European countries.

THE PROGRAMME

The Course is designed as an open space of mutual learning, based on non formal education methodologies. It will be implemented with the support of a Team composed by trainers from the Youth Directorate of the Council of Europe, the European Youth Forum and Children Rights activists, as well as voluntary members of the International Commission of Esplac. In total, a group of 6 Team members committed to the course success.

The course is divided into the following blocks:

- Human Rights Education and its link with Children Rights, Participation and Social Inclusion
- Theatre of the Oppressed techniques as a tool to promote Human Rights Education
- Educational action in the local context with children, based on the experience sharing among participants
- Planning future projects and cooperation among partner organisations

PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

The course is open to 26 participants from organisations located in Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Portugal, United Kingdom and Spain.

Participants attending the course should already be experienced in non-formal education, actively involved in the youth field and willing to develop international partnership. It is not necessary to have previous experience on the issues addressed in the course, but we request an open approach, readiness for an intercultural learning experience and interest in developing strategies and projects addressed to children. That's why selected participants will have to fill in a brief questionnaire to be sent before the course. Information compiled from the questionnaires will be used by the Team of Trainers to prepare specific sessions of the course.

The training course will be carried out in English language!!! Therefore all participants should be able to fully participate in English! Bear in mind that nobody will be native speaker, so be confident with your competences and be ready to develop your communication skills!

Please, find attached the <u>application form</u> and send it to Esplac in the <u>indicated deadline</u>. Participants will be selected by the Team of Trainers under the recommendations of partner organisations. The main principles for the selection will be: motivation of participants, involvement in their organisations and the most important: <u>willingness to develop concrete follow up after the course</u>. Diversity, geographical and gender balance will be objective data when defining the selected group of participants.

FINANCIAL AND PRACTICAL CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

• Travel expenses

The 70 % of travel expenses will be reimbursed on presentation of the relevant receipts. Only participants <u>attending to the whole duration of the training course</u> <u>can be reimbursed</u>. The payment will be made at the end of the course in cash (in Euros). There are some maximum travel costs foreseen in the budget, so, <u>before buying tickets all participants must consult the organisers</u>.

Accommodation

Board and lodging will be provided and paid by the Organisers of the Training Course. Participants will be accommodated in rooms of four/five people. The venue of the course will be at <u>Ruta del Ferro Youth Hostel</u>, located in the Catalan Pyrenees village of Sant Joan de les Abadesses.

Enrolment fee

There will be an enrolment fee of 60 € for participants coming from Austria, Belgium, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Portugal, Spain and United Kingdom, and 30 € for participants coming from Czech Republic, Latvia and Lithuania. Fees will be deducted from travel reimbursement.
