On this Training Course you will learn how to develop a Youth Democracy Project and complete an application for a grant of maximum €50 000 from Youth in Action.

Participants and target groups

We would like to invite all youth groups such as youth councils, youth organisations and youth clubs to send a team to this Training Course. The participants need to have plans to develop a Youth Democracy Project through Youth in Action around topics of youth participation. The project should support or promote young people's active role in society and issues that affect young people.

Each team must consist of at least 2 participants (1 youth worker/leader/coordinator and 1-2 young persons).

All participants must have a good level of English.

Aim and objectives

Based on the participants' previous experience, competence, needs and motivation, they will learn how to develop a Youth Democracy Project through interactive and non-formal learning methods. Through group work, brainstorming, simulation, games, debates and discussions the participants will create projects and understand how to complete applications for grants from Youth in Action.

The participants will

- gain an in-depth understanding of Youth Democracy Projects and how to apply for grants from Youth in Action
- develop a project, write an action plan and complete an application
- learn methods and be given tools for planning and running a Youth Democracy Project
- experience how one finds and cooperates with a project partner
