



MAKING IT REALITY ...

'ACTION' SEMINAR from 2nd to 6th of June 2011, Helsinki - Finland



This event will gather young people and youth workers coming from cultural minority groups from all over Europe and wishing to develop the visibility of their local project.

Objectives:

- To promote the image of young people from cultural minorities and multicultural societies in general
- To enhance project promoters' competences to increase the visibility of their projects at local level
- To identify benefits of projects
- To share good practices
- To learn more about Youth Pass and Non Formal Learning
- To develop future plans to implement actions/projects at local level

We will use active methods, including a public event to experience "in real" how to work on the visibility of a project.

Profile of participants:

We are looking for teams of one youth worker + 1-2 young people from the same group at local level. Youth workers can come to the event alone if they justify it. Young people should be accompanied by a youth worker.
