Goals

People in Peril Association

People in Peril is a non-profit civil society association, established in Slovakia in 1999. Our aims are providing effective support to those who suffer the consequences of natural catastrophes, conflicts and authoritarian regimes; and promoting global education among young people and students in Slovakia in order to contribute to forming open and tolerant society. Our activities range from Humanitarian Aid and Development Cooperation to Human Rights Advocacy; Education and Awareness Raising Activities in Slovakia. The primary target groups of educational activities by People in Peril NGO are young people, volunteers, school teachers, pupils and students.

The idea for organizing this training was inspired by the wish of our volunteers to learn more about the problems of today's globalized world and to gain new competences in organizing and facilitating peer education activities on the topics of global education for youngsters on the local or international level.

The main objectives of the training therefore are:

- to enrich the participants' knowledge of the global education main topics (also through experience)
- to train the participants in using non-formal education methods for their later use within their activities of peer global education
- to give participants the possibility of presentation of their GOs/NGOs and also to get acquainted with international organizations sharing the interest in cooperation on educational projects concerning the Global education
- to provide participants with space for sharing tips of good practice and their ideas for successful youth work
- to get more familiar with the opportunities provided by Youth in Action program with the relevance to the participants' needs and experience
- to provide a platform for partnership building and induce cooperation among the participants
- to support a creative atmosphere and inspire participants to design projects for the near future on the local, national and international level

Reimbursement of the travel costs
