# WHY A PARTNERSHIP BUILDING ACTIVITY ... FOCUSING ON YOUTH EXCHANGES!?

We hear it often ...youth exchanges change young people's life! And yes ... they do indeed. It is not only a great and fun project, but if done well ... especially rich in learning for all those involved!

Youth exchanges have played a very important role in the past years and remain a cornerstone in the mobility programmes of the European Commission for the coming years. The launching of the new Programme Erasmus + also underlines the importance of such Youth Exchanges as a powerful tool for young people to empower themselves and to grow towards active citizens of their own community up to European and global level.

The National Agency of Norway and Portugal for the Youth in Action programme launch therefore this Partnership Building Activity (=PBA), with a clear focus on increasing the cooperation between NGO's and groups from Northern and Southern Europe. "MAKING THE DIFFERENCE" aims therefore also to connect the young people from both corners of Europe.

This PBA will take place in a rural village in the centre of Portugal: 'Vila da Marmeleira' with 460 habitants. Over the past 2 years, different international activities (including YiA) have been introduced in this community, offering a winwin situation for all involved with local development/change through their involvement in the activities and a deep intercultural experience for the participants. This village seems to us a good setting to organize this Partnership Building Activity "MAKING THE DIFFERENCE", where NORTH MEETS SOUTH.

#### TARGET GROUP

- → Max 25 participants from CROATIA, CYPRUS, MALTA, NORWAY, PORTUGAL AND SPAIN
- → Being able to use English as working language
- → Having a true and real interest in establishing partnerships
- → Youth workers and youth leaders who can represent their youth group's interest
- → This Partnership Building Activity is also open for youth workers and leaders who wish to start with youth exchanges in their organization or group.



# **OBJECTIVES**

- To create an opportunity to find good and reliable partners to make youth exchanges with
- To understand what is needed to plan a youth exchange of good quality.
- To create a solid networks of contacts and partnerships
- To equip the youth workers with insight in their role as coach and support.
- To experience the possibilities of local involvement.
- To understand the impact and social change a youth exchange can have within the local community.

## **DURATION**

Participants are expected to be part of the full duration of the Partnership Building Activity. All board and lodging is foreseen from Monday 25<sup>th</sup> of November dinner time, till after breakfast on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> of November 2013.
